GENERAL NOTICE TO ALL GARDEN GUESTS REGARDING PHOTOGRAPHY:

1. SURVEILLANCE - This Sculpture Prayer Garden is under 24/7 video surveillance at all times. By entering this private property you agree to be photographed. Your images on this private property may be used without your knowledge, consent or payment.
2. COPYRIGHTS & TRADEMARKS - All artwork, architecture, graphics and designs are protected by copyright and trademark registration. They cannot be copied or reproduced or photographed for commercial use without the written permission of the artists or architects who own the copyrights. Artist/Architect, Max Greiner, Jr. owns the copyrights and trademarks to the architecture, graphics and majority of the art displayed in this garden. TCKF does NOT own any copyrights or trademarks.
3. PHOTO CREDITS – Both amateur and professional photography (in all forms) must give photo credit to TCKF and to the individual artists whose artwork is featured. The name of the garden (The Coming King Sculpture Prayer Garden), the artist and the artwork should be stated. (i.e. "Divine Servant"® is the copyrighted work of Max Greiner, Jr.)
4. AMATEUR PHOTOGRAPHY – There is no restriction for personal use or amateur (non-commercial) still photography, video, audio or social media posting. However, the name of the garden, the artist and artwork should be stated. (It is not necessary to complete this Application for non-commercial photography.)
5. PROFESSIONAL PHOTOGRAPHY - Professional, commercial photography will be considered and allowed on a case by case basis. This Application must be completed as an initial step. Written permission from TCKF and the individual artist, designer or architect is required. Fees or donations to TCKF will be negotiated, based on the project size. This applies to any professional recording of images, still, photo, video, documentary or movie. Note, all rights to the individual pieces of fine art, architecture and designs are owned by the individual artists themselves, not TCKF. Commercial use must be negotiated individually with the artist, regarding fair compensation and use. One separate one time or multiple use licensing contracts may be required. A duplicate copy of the photography (or B-roll video) must be submitted to TCKF and the Artist within 30 days of shoot. TCKF and the individual artist have the right to use the

photography with proper photo credit. The artist and commercial photographer will negotiate their own terms of use in a separate contract.

6. DRONES – Drone operators (both amateur and professional) must accept all liability and obtain all required licenses. Drone cannot be used at the garden without prior written approval. Drones must be operated in a safe manner that does not interfere with activities or guests at the garden. This Application must be submitted to TCKF for Drone photography on the garden property. A duplicate copy of the images or B-role must be submitted to TCKF within 30 days of the shoot on a disk or thumb drive. At least one copy of the finished professional project must be submitted to TCKF and the artists with 30 days of completion.

PROFESSIONAL PHOTOGRAPHER REQUIREMENTS:

1. All professional photographers must complete this Application.
2. Permission is required from the Artists who own the copyrights and trademarks to their art.
3. The artist and TCKF have the right to forbid use or distribution of any images taken.
4. Visitors' access to the 77' cross itself cannot be blocked during a photo session.
5. No selling or marketing of photography products will be allowed without TCKF written approval.
6. A fee or donation will be required for using artwork in commercial photographic projects.
7. A credit line for the artists and TCKF must appear in any publication, website, social media posting, presentation or video which features the garden, or garden art. Example: "Divine Servant"® art is the copyrighted & trademarked creation of Max Greiner, Jr.
