

THOUSANDS DRAWN TO TEXAS SCULPTURE PRAYER GARDEN

Thousands of visitors are coming to THE COMING KING SCULPTURE PRAYER GARDEN, in the Texas Hill Country on IH-10. The free art park is located in Kerrville, TX just one hour northwest of San Antonio, home of the top two tourist attractions in Texas, the Alamo and River Walk.

The non-profit, non-denominational, Christian art garden, which is not a church or ministry, is drawing hundreds of thousands of visitors from all 50 states and at least 44 countries. In 2015, an estimated 94,593 visitors came to the garden in 36,382 vehicles, almost four times the population of Kerrville. The garden had an estimated 91,250 visitors in 2014 and 73,000 in 2013.

The dramatic tourism numbers are the result of many factors. THE COMING KING FOUNDATION has distributed over 100,000 pieces of promotional literature, expensive color brochures, and "Cross Over Texas" Auto Decals. For over a year, the spiritual art garden has also been promoted weekly, via a 30 minute radio show called "The Cross At Kerrville". This radio program is broadcast across a large part of Texas on KSLR 630 in San Antonio, and KTXW 1100 in Austin. The unusual radio show talks about the miracles that frequently occur at the garden.

Recently, NATIONAL CAR SALES in Kerrville provided a Smart Car to TCKF, which has been wrapped with colorful images from the garden, by TNJ ENGRAVING. The tiny car features dramatic photos of the monumental art and miracles at the garden. The CROSSMOBILE will be driven most of the time by the CROSS LADY, Nancy Redhead, TCKF Administrator, in an effort to draw attention to the Christian art garden.

Worldwide attention will soon be focused on Kerrville when Dr. Pat Robertson's "700 CLUB" broadcasts a special feature on the spiritual art park, via the CHRISTIAN BROADCASTING NETWORK. The program is scheduled to air around the world during EASTER 2016.

This Christian sculpture park is unlike any art or religious attraction anywhere in the world. Thousands of people are coming to see the 2.25 million dollars worth of monumental, Christ-honoring art donated by three artists. This includes "The Empty Cross", created by TCKF founder, artist and evangelist, Max Greiner, Jr. The iconic, 77'7" contemporary Cor-tin Steel sculpture is billed as the most symbolic cross sculpture in the world. The blood colored Resurrection cross is the Narrow Gate, the Way, the Door, the Strong Tower, the Mighty Fortress and the Light of the World.

A contributor to the top travel website, TRIP ADVISOR posted these comments on 12/31/15: ***"AMAZING SITE TO VISIT! Take the time to visit the Coming King Sculpture Prayer Garden just off I 10 in Kerrville, Texas. Read the plaques posted on the inside of the 77'7" steel cross and experience the real-life miracles that occurred during the construction of this amazing place. The bronze art is phenomenal! I have traveled around the world and can't think of any place I've seen life-sized art that is any better than the pieces displayed on the cross-shaped walkway at the top of the mountain. Ample parking, piped music, amazing views, phenomenal art, I just can't say enough about the beauty and majesty of***

this place. AND IT'S FREE to visit! Take the time needed and give yourself the opportunity to one amazing blessing!" Sherryhub, Junction, TX

However, most people are visiting the Christian art garden because they sense the tangible presence of God on the 24.5 acre property. As a result, thousands of people have had life changing experiences on the holy ground. Many guests claim physical and emotional healings at the foot of the cross. To this date, at least 19 people have abandoned their plans for suicide, after visiting the Christian garden. 77 Bible verses are engraved into 16" Scripture Tiles, written in three languages, are displayed in the 300' long cross-shaped garden.

A limestone "Prayer Rock" was found along the 600' "Prayer Path" which said: ***"Thank you Lord for bringing me to the cross, and not allowing me to go through with suicide." Glenda.***

Thousands of visitors have also experienced supernatural signs and wonders at the garden, which are predicted to follow Christian believers in the last days (Mark 16:17). A sparkling substance that looks like fine glitter, or glitter make-up, has formed on the skin and clothing of thousands of visitors seeking God. This unknown substance has been tested by TEXAS A&M UNIVERSITY. Many believe the supernatural particles are the visible Shekinah Glory of God, mentioned in Isaiah 60:1, Exodus 34:29 and Act 7:55 in the Bible.

Southern Baptist, Lisa Alley from Fort Worth wrote on 1/13 /16: ***"I'm not sure of the exact date, but my mother and sister-in-laws took a Girls Trip to Kerrville. We saw the cross from the road and decided to stop and see it on our way back home. I was so in awe when we got there that I hit my knees and began to worship in the gravel parking lot!!!! We walked around and while standing in the cross we noticed the signs on the inside. I'm not much on structured prayer. I believe it comes from your heart and is different every time. However, we decided to pray the prayer on the plaques inside the cross anyway. We held out our hands, prayed and opened our eyes. We all had the sparkling of Glory Dust!!!!!! A miracle right before our eyes!!! I was so on fire that I could have run back to Fort Worth!!!! I sparkled for months after. I so enjoyed sharing my glorious dusting with everyone I knew, and strangers too!!!! I know my healing took place 2000 years ago, but what a confirmation of HIS presence I received at THE CROSS!!!!"***

Hundreds of visitors have taken photographs around the giant seven story cross, which have revealed strange balls of light, called Angel Orbs. Thousands of these strange circular objects have been photographed by guests at night, with and without a flash. These transparent moving spheres have also be recorded on video. Angel Orbs are believed to be the angelic creatures referenced in Ezekiel 1:15 of the Bible. Humanoid figures have occasionally be photographed. However, hundreds of people have repeatedly witnessed at night, a strange blue cloud that moves around the cross and over worshippers. This cloud was captured on security video and is believed to be the Holy Spirit, or a type of angel. On one occasion, during the day, a white vertical cloud appeared behind the giant cross and was captured on security video. It remained for about 40 minutes and was witnessed by at least five people, including the 911 operator.

The art garden is chartered as a 501c3, non-profit art museum. However, unlike churches, ministries or most sculpture parks, the Kerrville garden is open 365 days a year, 17 hours a day. Visitors have come from as far away as Finland, they have stayed as long as 42 days. Some out of town guests have returned over 200 times. Many pilgrims bring others with them to experience the power of God. Some guests believe the 1,930' high mountain is a spiritual portal where Heaven is connected to earth.

On 1/5/16, Larry Hodgson, of Victoria, CANADA drove all the way to Kerrville after hearing about the garden: ***“What you are doing here, it is just phenomenal! I’m blown away! It is phenomenal! A lot is going on up there. God is doing a new thing, a new paradigm. He is not doing things the same way. This is phenomenal. A new portal has opened up on the top of that mountain. I feel like Moses walking up into the presence of God. The angels are coming there to resupply. This is phenomenal!”***

The next major event at the Kerrville art garden will occur over the four day EASTER holiday. Last year came 2,246 people to the holy mountain over the EASTER holidays. On Saturday, 4/26/16, TCKF will again host a RESURRECTION CELEBRATION, which will start at 11:00 AM and ends at 6:00 PM. This free event will feature seven Christian music groups, and six inspiring speakers from different Christian denominations.

On Sunday morning, TCKF will host a special, non-denominational, SON RISE EASTER Service, which will begin at 7:00 AM. All events are free to the public.

ABOUT THE GARDEN: The 24.5 acre art park is the only place in the world where the 77’7” contemporary sculpture called *“The Empty Cross”* can be seen. It is the “Most Symbolic Cross Sculpture in the World”. In addition, seven other monumental sculptures can also be viewed at this location. It is also the only place in the world where all of Greiner’s monumental sculptures are on display. A “Path To Heaven” uses 77 scriptures, in multiple languages, to present the Gospel of Jesus Christ. The free garden is open from 7:00 AM until midnight, 365 days a year.
