Finland Comes To Kerrville Cross

The world appears to be making tracks to the Kerrville Cross, a giant Cor-ten steel sculpture in the heart of the Texas Hill Country, just one hour northwest of San Antonio on IH-10. Thousands of people from across Texas, the USA and world are now coming to Kerrville. The park happens to be at the same latitude as Israel, and approximately halfway between the Atlantic and Pacific Oceans, on the transcontinental interstate highway.

Many people claim to have experienced the supernatural power and presence of Almighty God at the non-denominational Christian garden. Visitors report changed lives, physical and emotional healings. Others report dramatic, supernatural signs and wonders, such as the appearance of an unknown sparkling substance that forms on their hands, faces and clothing. Some claim these tiny particles are the visible glory of God mentioned in the Bible in Isaiah 60:1 and Exodus 34:29. Major scientific laboratories, including one at **Texas A&M University**, admit the supernatural substance exists, but are unable to explain its precise composition or origin since it is not on the chart of basic elements in the universe.

In addition, thousands of round balls of light called “Angel Orbs” have been photographed at night around the towering cross. Many people claim these are the angelic beings described by the Jewish Prophet Ezekiel (Ez. 1:15). Some of these round globes of light have been photographed around the cross at night without the use of a camera flash, proving they are not light reflections of dust in front of the camera lens. A few rare photographs reveal unexplainable humanoid angelic forms near the cross.

Recent national and international stories in newspapers, magazines, radio, television and websites, like www.giganticstatues.com, have allowed people to learn about **The Coming King Sculpture Prayer Garden** in Kerrville, TX.

This week, the Martti Falck family traveled 9,000 miles from Tampere, Finland to see the 77’7” massive contemporary sculpture called “*The Empty Cross*”. This unique cross is believed to be the most symbolic cross sculpture in the world. The blood-colored Resurrection cross by artist/evangelist, Max Greiner, Jr., symbolizes the Narrow Gate, the Open Door, the Way, the Light, the Strong Tower and the Mighty Fortress, all metaphors for Jesus Christ.

Pastor, Martti Falck and his wife, Anu, host a Christian television show for children which airs in Finland and Russia. The Falcks have been planning a trip to see the giant open cross since they first heard about it several years ago. ***“I felt something coming into Kerrville. It was amazing. I did not know where the cross would be. I have seen thousands of crosses around the world, in over 60 nations, but I have never seen an empty cross. It will draw international attention to Kerrville. The Empty Cross will touch the nations.”***

Pastor Falck proclaimed ***"You only need for your life one empty cross. It is about Jesus, not art. It would be wonderful to see the Prayer Garden around the world, especially in Israel."***

Many people travel to the garden just to see the eight monumental, Christ-honoring sculptures now on display. The installed art, which is worth about \$2,350,000, was donated by three internationally collected artists, Beverly Paddleford of Lander, WY, David Broussard of Dallas TX, and Max Greiner, Jr. of Kerrville, TX.

The massive, seven-story cross sculpture weighing approximately 70 tons, is the focal point of the 23 acre Texas park. Though the non-denominational garden is unfinished due to lack of funds, people are still flocking to the the garden, which is free to the public and open from 6:00 AM until midnight, 365 days a year.

The 46 year old pastor, who speaks three languages said: ***"The Empty Cross means to me that God sent His Son to die for my sins and set me free. I came 9,000 miles from my home in Finland to see the cross. Sometimes you have to go far to see near. I am praying that every American would see near, pray for this wonderful nation and turn back to God."***

When asked about his perception of the USA, the pastor from Finland had a sober warning: ***"America has lost its values. When I first came to the US 29 years ago, I was very proud. I dearly loved America. But, my heart is really hurt now to see all the broken families. Something has been lost in this country. America needs to get back to the principles of the Founding Fathers: God, fathers, hard work and Christian values. The biggest problem is the lack of fathers in America. Many families have been lost."***

Pastor Falck went on to say that seeing the Kerrville garden was the highlight of his family's month long visit to the USA.
