# II. TCKF Training Introduction (5/20/15) ©

## A. TCKF Purpose & Objectives

1. Serve our guests - Meet needs (Bring glory & souls to Jesus)
2. Explain garden vision – (Our testimony)
3. Inspire, entertain, educate, challenge & connect
4. Present Gospel – Make the way straight (Mt 3:33 & Isa 40:3)
5. Explain Salvation (Born-again) experience & Empowerment experience (Baptism of the Holy Spirit)
6. Pray for group at end of presentation (Pray for individuals afterwards)
7. Seek support (Donations, prayer, AOTC members, PAVERS & volunteers)

## B. Definitions:

1. VFD – Volunteer Fire Department - (TCKF Volunteers)
2. Tour Guide Chaplain – Presents story of garden, the Gospel, Empowerment & prays for needs

## C. Training Process

1. Fill out Volunteer Application
2. Trained, certified, commissioned & sent out
3. Training – Refresher Course/Recertification

## D. Qualifications, Responsibilities & Reports (See Application)

1. Must be a Born-again & Empowered Christian (Explain & Pray)
2. Must be 18 years or older & Submit to Criminal Background check
3. Must complete a TCKF Volunteer Application
4. Must serve at the garden each month
5. Must file written “Fruit Reports” in short narrative form
6. Must be recertified annually by TCKF
7. Submit to TCKF authority & serve in unity with Tour Guide Chaplains
8. Must know the basic story (history) of the garden
9. Must be willing to share the Gospel, including the Empowerment
10. Must be willing to pray publically out loud, with a group & individually
11. Must be willing to pray for all needs of guests, such as healing, addictions, abuse, finances, relationships, etc.
12. Be willing to seek a commitment (decision for Christ) Ask for the Order!
13. Document answered prayers (i.e. testimony, photography, Comment Cards, witnesses & evidence)
14. Must wear TCKF red Servant’s Apron while on duty

# III. TCKF: Our Story/His Story (5/20/15) ©

## A. **POWER POINT PRESENTATION**

1. Public Visual Presentation of garden "Vision"
2. Tour Guides can give POWER POINT presentations to groups (i.e. churches, conventions, meetings, events, conferences & civic clubs)

## IV. TCKF Chaplain Role (5/20/15) ©

- A. **Present Gospel** (Salvation / Born-again Experience)
  - 1. Be prepared, know the Gospel (Take an evangelism course)
  - 2. Allow God to touch the person at cross BEFORE we do!
  - 3. Be observant - Determine why visitor came to the cross
  - 4. Are they desperate, have a pressing need, or just curious?
  - 5. Sample starter questions: *Welcome to the garden, where are you from? Why are you here? How can we serve you? What do you need from God? Do you know where you will be in 1000 years? Do you know Jesus? If you died tomorrow, are you certain heaven will be your eternal home?*
  - 6. Present Gospel (If not saved, or unsure) & try to lead to Christ
  - 7. Answer questions (Refer guests to Scripture and TEC brochures/stealth tracts)
  - 8. Don't let guests leave without blessing them with a simple prayer, even if they reject the Gospel and Jesus.
  
- B. **Present Empowerment** (Baptism in the Holy Spirit)
  - 1. After Salvation explain Water Baptism & Empowerment Spirit Baptism
  - 2. Explain that all Christians have all of God once they are Born-again, but God wants more of them!
  - 3. God wants to give (Or release) good, supernatural Gifts (1 Cor 12 & Acts)
  - 4. We all must be empowered for ultimate service & equipped for spiritual warfare we are all in
  - 5. Soldiers in God's army must be "armed & dangerous" to devil!
  - 6. Pray for activation of gifts & have guests pray themselves in agreement
  - 7. Explain the 9 supernatural gifts (I Cor 12) if time is available
  - 8. Answer guest questions
  
- C. **Pray For All Needs**
  - 1. Ask what guest needs from God? (Ask Holy Spirit to reveal needs)
  - 2. Pray with guests and have them pray out loud themselves
  - 3. Have guests forgive all who hurt them & break any curses, if necessary
  - 4. Speak blessings, freedom and healing over guests
  
- D. **Direct Guests To Resources & Help**
  - 1. Offer free TCKF literature, CDs, auto decal & Bibles
  - 2. Offer help of local churches, ministries & counseling (i.e. Salvation Army)

# V. TCKF Tour Guide Role (5/20/15) ©

## A. Present Garden Story

1. Tell story of the garden and *"The Empty Cross"* (TEC)
2. Explain how God established this garden with prophecy, miracles, signs & wonders
3. Few ministries in the world have as many documented miracles as we have occurring related to the garden. This is GOD!
4. Answer questions

## B. Present Gospel, Empowerment & Pray For All Needs

1. Use our story as a means to present the reality of Jesus
2. Present basic Gospel (Salvation/Born-gain Experience)
3. Pray with group for Salvation experience (ABCs – ask, believe, confess)
4. Present basic Empowerment experience (Do you want everything God has for you? Do you want everything you need to serve God effectively?)
5. Pray for Empowerment Baptism (Filling, Baptism of the Holy Spirit)
6. Instruct guests to get Water Baptized, read Bible, pray, worship, give, join a good Christian church & serve others
7. Answer guest questions

## C. Direct Guests To Resources & Help

1. Offer guests free Bibles, TCKF brochures, CDs music, testimony & teaching
2. Explain that good resources are in all communities (churches & ministries)
3. Ask for support of this project (i.e. prayer, donations & volunteers)
4. Explain PAVERS, AOTC, Covenant Partners programs
5. Recommend TCKF websites:

6. Pray general blessing over group & explain individual prayer is available

# VI. Unscheduled Guests (5/20/15) ©

- A. **Allow God To Touch People Before We Do** (WAIT on the LORD)
  - 1. Welcome and then watch guests from distance
  - 2. Allow them to have private time with art, Scripture & God
  - 3. Approach guests after they leave the cross
  
- B. **Determine Reason For Visit**
  - 1. What is needed from God? (Salvation, Empowerment Baptism, healing, financial, addictions, abuse, bad relationships, etc.)
  - 2. Ask Holy Spirit to give right questions to ask guests
  
- C. **Allow Holy Spirit To Direct Ministry Efforts**
  - 1. Determine God's priority & method of ministry
  - 2. Follow His leading – Don't force a formula – be gentle & sensitive
  
- D. **Interview**
  - 1. Ask Probing Questions – Pray for wisdom & discernment
  - 2. Holy Spirit will give Words of Knowledge, Word of Wisdom & Prophecy
  - 3. Watch body language & eyes
  
- E. **Ministry Response** (PRAY for direction)
  - 1. Follow Holy Spirit lead (Be gentle, but sometimes confrontation is needed)
  - 2. Determine if guest is Saved/Born-again (Required for additional ministry)
  - 3. Follow with Empowerment Baptism (Required for additional ministry)
  - 4. Ask God to reveal other needs (Forgiveness, addictions, strongholds, soul ties, curses, false religions, witchcraft, evil oaths, abuse, etc.)

  - 1. TCKF supplies

# X. TCKF Procedures & Policies (5/20/15) ©

## **A. Certification**

1. Certification issued by TCKF Executive Committee, based on recommendations of Trustees and Committee Chairmen
2. Tour Guide Chaplains must complete Application
3. Tour Guide Chaplains must attend Training Classes or listen to new audio training
4. Certification automatically expires after one year from the original date of certification
5. Certification can be renewed after review by the Executive Committee

## **B. Commissioning**

1. Approved Tour Guide Chaplains will be officially commissioned by the TCKF Executive Committee
2. Actual Commissioning & Presentations will occur at the cross

## **C. Revocation**

1. Tour Guide Chaplains will be removed from duty if TCKF Executive Committee determines that any unethical or improper behavior has occurred
2. Tour Guide Chaplains will be removed from duty if they are unable, or unwilling to fulfill their commitment to TCKF and God
3. Revocation can be appealed in writing to the Executive Committee within 30 days

## **D. Difficult Situations**

1. Dangerous or emergency situations - Call 911
2. Irreverent or disrespectful situations (i.e. atheists, witches, Satanists, false religions, etc.) – Bind demons and take appropriate actions
3. Mental or demonic manifestations

# XI. TCKF Garden Schedules

(5/20/15) ©

## A. Minimum Hours - None

1. It is the desire of TCKF that Tour Guide Chaplains serve at least 4 hours per month to maintain certification.
2. Exceptions will be made for illness or other special circumstances

## B. Scheduled Hours

1. Tour Guide Chaplains can schedule fixed weekly hours
2. These hours will be posted on the TCKF Monthly Calendar, so others can be aware
3. It is the ultimate desire of TCKF to have Tour Guide Chaplains on duty during all open hours (6:00 AM to midnight)
4. Largest visitor attendance normally occurs on the weekends and holidays

## C. Random Hours

1. Tour Guide Chaplain can serve at the garden at any time, without advance notice to TCKF
2. It is recommended that all Tour Guide Chaplains be sensitive to the Holy Spirit as to when they should be at the garden

## D. Scheduled Tours

1. Many people, groups and churches reserve prearrange tours
2. Tours Guide Chaplains will be recruited for scheduled tours
3. Team Teaching is recommended
4. Tour Guide Chaplains should expect to spend additional time ministering to individuals following tour presentations
5. At some future date, TCKF may schedule official tours at fixed daily times, like other national park attractions

## E. Fire Alarm Alerts

1. Fire Alarm Alerts may be issued when large number of visitors are at the garden
2. TCKF Fire Marshall will coordinate responses & determine ALARM number
3. One ALARM = approximately 10 visitors, Five ALARM = approximately 50
4. Any TCKF Trustee or volunteer can call for reinforcements, as needed
5. A TCKF "Dispatcher" may issue FIRE ALARM ALERTS via email, text & phone

# XII. TCKF Conclusion

(5/20/15) ©

## A. TCKF Volunteer Fire Department

1. Certified Tour GuidesChaplains are representatives of The Coming King Foundation and of the Most High God
2. Therefore, the highest ethical standards should be maintained and presented to the public

## B. Most High God

1. TCKF welcomes all people to the garden. However, only the one true God: Father, Son and Holy Spirit is honored at this garden.
2. The worship of other gods or spirits is not allowed on this holy ground.
3. This garden is private property, not public property, therefore we are not required to give access to anyone, or accommodate false religions

## C. Doctrine

1. The Coming King Sculpture Prayer Garden is a (non-denominational) free Christian tourist attraction
2. Focus on the Scriptural truths and the universal doctrines accepted by the Christian church. Please avoid denominational doctrines that are not Scripturally based.
3. Remember, as John Wimber used to say: ***“The plain things are the main things, and the main things are the plain things.”***

## D. Ultimate Objective

1. It is the desire of TCKF that ever person who visits the Sculpture Prayer Garden has a genuine encounter with the one true God.
2. Ideally, each person will leave with a personal relationship with Jesus Christ
3. In addition, it is hoped that each visitor will be empowered by the Holy Spirit, by receiving the nine Gifts of the Holy Spirit (1 Cor 12), so they might most effectively serve God.
4. Finally, realize that many people will come to the cross out of need & desperation, seeking a miracle, deliverance, healing and divine intervention from God

## E. Final Words & Prayer

# TCKF TOUR GUIDE CHAPLAIN CERTIFICATION 5/20/15

1. If someone desires to serve as a TCKF Tour Guide Chaplain and is willing to put in the time, effort and prayer, they should review the requirements and fill out the Application. Candidates agree to listen to the Training CDs (which are available online or on discs) and read all the Course Outline materials. Finally, they must agree to spend time each month serving at the garden.
2. After the Applicant has completed all the requirements and has submitted their Application to the TCKF Office (either by hand, email or mail), the Administrative Director sends the signed Application to the Ministry Committee Chairman (VFD Fire Marshall) and the Executive Committee, with recommendations.
3. The Ministry Committee Chairman prayerfully reviews the Application and makes his personal recommendation to the Executive Committee.
4. At the request of the Chairman, the Executive Committee votes to approve, or disapprove, the Applicant after prayer and discussion. Votes can be made by email or phone, and directed to the TCKF Office.
5. If the Applicant is approved by the Executive Committee, the Administrative Director notifies the Chairman and Applicant by email and phone, informing everyone of the Tour Guide Chaplain Certification approval by TCKF. This email notification should be copied to the entire TCKF Board, and other currently active Tour Guide Chaplains, for their information.
6. The Ministry Chairman then makes arrangements with the new TCKF Tour Guide Chaplain to commission them, to set them in place, by praying and laying on hands at or near the Cross.
7. During this formal or informal installation ceremony, the new Tour Guide Chaplain is welcomed into God's service and given the red Servant's Apron. In addition, they are given a TOUR GUIDE CHAPLAIN ON DUTY signs. Any questions can be answered at that time.
8. If the new Tour Guide Chaplain desires to have regular hours at the garden, they should inform the TCKF office, so the times can be posted on the website Calendar.
9. All Tour Guide Chaplains are encouraged to submit written "Fruit Reports" to TCKF, in the form of a narrative report, or using the "Fruit Report" standard form. This data will be compiled and distributed by the TCKF office, as necessary.

## TCKF Tour Guide Chaplain Polices

Any Christian can share Jesus Christ and pray for people at THE COMING KING SCULPTURE PRAYER GARDEN. However, only trained and certified Tour Guides Chaplains officially represent TCKF. These screened volunteers are members of “**TCKF Volunteer Fire Department**” (VFD), under the authority of the “**Fire Marshall**”, and the **TCKF Executive Committee**. Approved applicants will be presented with a TCKF Red Apron and commissioned for one year of service. All applicants must be “Born-again” and “Empowered” (Baptized In the Holy Spirit) because someone cannot give away what they don’t have. All applicants must be willing to serve as both “tour guides” and “chaplains” to fulfill the evangelistic mission of TCKF.

- **Chaplain Role** – Applicants must be willing to present the Gospel of Jesus Christ, including the Salvation (Born-again experience) and Empowerment (Baptism of the Holy Spirit Experience) to all guests at the garden. They must be willing, as the Holy Spirit leads, to also pray for other personal needs including inner and physical healing.
- **Tour Guide Role** – Applicants must be very familiar with the continuing story and facts about the garden, its history, artwork and donor artists. Many visitors come to the garden for non-spiritual reasons. Our evangelistic strategy is to draw people to Jesus Christ using beautiful artwork, landscaping, panoramic views, walking trails and other attractions. These free tours provide are a means of presenting the Gospel to guests. Normally, an evangelistic invitation should be given at the end of a tour presentation, which is usually about 15 to 30 minutes long. It is recommended that at least two Tour Guide Chaplains be onsite for each scheduled tour, if possible.
- **Service At Garden** - All Applicants must be willing to spend time each month at the garden functioning as a Tour Guide Chaplain. These times can be spontaneous as the Holy Spirit leads, or prearranged, scheduled times. Failure to serve at the garden during a month is grounds for removal as a certified TCKF Tour Guide Chaplain. All Applicants must also be willing to provide tours for scheduled groups, when possible. It is highly recommended that all Chaplains take an evangelism course to sharpen their evangelistic skills.
- **Fruit Reports** - Tour Guide Chaplains should submit a brief “Fruit Report” summary, in some form, following their sessions at the garden. These “Fruit Reports” are used to inspire other Tour Guide Chaplains, to evaluate and document our evangelistic efforts. Most Tour Guide Chaplains prefer to submit a short narrative report of three or four paragraphs. “Fruit Reports” should be emailed to the TCKF Office and other Tour Guide Chaplains.
- **Requirements** - Applicants must: 1) listen to all TCKF audio training online, or on CDs. 2) Read all Tour Guide Chaplain training materials, which are online. 3) Submit a Tour Guide Chaplain Application. 4) Submit to a criminal background check. 5) Be willing to spend time each month serving at the garden. 4 hours minimum are recommended. 6) File a “Fruit Report”, in some form, within 48 hours of session, if possible. 7) Chaplains must maintain the highest ethical and moral standards or they will be removed, following a hearing and vote of the Executive Committee. The TCKF Red Apron must be surrendered at that time.

Note: TCKF certified Tour Guides Chaplains and must wear their red TCKF Aprons when serving in their official capacity at the garden, so guests can know who can be trusted to pray for them. Scheduled tours will be posted on the TCKF “Events Calendar” found on our website for all to see. It is the desire of TCKF that Tour Guide Chaplains are onsite during all open hours of the garden. **A BACKGROUND CHECK IS REQUIRED FOR ALL VOLUNTEERS THAT INTERMINGLE WITH VISITORS AND/OR FAMILIES.**

## TCKF Tour Guide Chaplain Sample Script by Col. Bill Lewis 4/30/15

The following sample tour script was provided by 91 year old Master Evangelist, Col. Bill Lewis on 4/9/15 for the benefit of other TCKF Tour Guide Chaplains. Col. Lewis, a Methodist, has led hundreds, possibly thousands of souls to Christ in his lifetime. Many of these people were brought to the LORD at THE COMING KING SCULPTURE PRAYER GARDEN where Bill faithfully spends many hours each week serving the LORD. Each Certified TOUR GUIDE CHAPLAIN is expected to develop his own script to present to garden visitors, based on available time and the leading of the Holy Spirit.

In keeping with what I believe is God's message to you and the prophets this is the basic information I convey to the tour groups I lead. Based on the time I have with individual visitors I try to share the basics of this text with them. I use the Lord's word, the info we received in training and your TCKF Tour Guide and Chaplain Duties outline as my primary source material.

The following is basically what my tour groups receive. The tour groups I have worked with generally are not interested in a wordy introduction. I call the contact person in advance to get a feel for what the group would like to see and do. If they are not interested in a long history and briefing I ask them to give me ten to fifteen minutes as soon as they get off the bus.

This is, in general, what I do and say: I do not read this nor do I have it memorized; but I cover the message herein contained.

**Welcome to the most amazing Christ centered attraction you will ever see. My name is Bill Lewis; I am on the volunteer staff of The Coming King Foundation; the foundation is a 501 3C non-profit organization; it is established as a museum, it is not affiliated with any Christian church or other organized Christian institution. However, it enjoys strong support from a large number of pastors and congregations in our area.**

**I mentioned I am a volunteer staff member; I have a dual job title; I am a Tour guide and a Chaplain; let me briefly explain my duties: Tour guide first; My job is just as simple as my title; I guide tours; you qualify; let me guide you. One of my most important duties is to point out that we are not yet blessed with indoor plumbing (some of you may have grown up on a farm during the dark ages and are familiar with outhouses) our substitute; you got it right, Porta-potties; they are located right over there. With that out of the way; you notice that I wear this red apron; it is to signify that I am here to serve you. The best way to serve is to determine your wants and needs; the only way to find out what they are is for you to tell me. I am happy to respond to your queries or comments. I do not mind being interrupted; feel free to ask your questions or make a statement any time the mood strikes you. That pretty well covers the guide duties.**

Now for the chaplain portion; I will begin responding to this duty with a prayer for each of you and for our time together. Before I begin this prayer let me point out that the majority of our visitors come to the Empty Cross to pray. If any, or all, of you have a prayer request please let me know. I will pray for you before you leave or you may write your request and leave it in the Yellow box I will point out on our tour. A TCKF prayer warrior team lifts all of the written requests up in prayer.

An aside, when you drop your prayer requests in the box the Foundation folks would appreciate a comment card, cards are available, please ask; we want to know what your views are and also any suggestions you may have to improve your experience in the Garden.

The yellow box serves another purpose; you may be curious to know where all of the funding to build this magnificent Garden and Cross came from; the short answer is; it came from nice folks like you. Everything you see here, including the real estate, is paid for. Nothing was, or is, undertaken until the funds are available. You are cordially invited to join us in contributing to God's beautiful garden.

You are also invited to write your requests (or any other message) on one of the rocks you will find along the Mediation Path, felt tipped pens are available, please ask. I will point out the path on our tour. The writings you will observe along the path are similar to the requests people have been writing and leaving in the stones along the West wall of the Temple Mound in Jerusalem for many, many years.

Before I explain the balance of my Chaplain duties let us go to our Loving Lord in prayer; .....Amen I offer a short inclusive prayer that covers the group, their families, church, our nation and any group concern they have shared with me.

You have just experience one of my major privileges; taking the requests of many suffering souls to the Lord; I rejoice that not all of the requests are for the suffering; praise and thanksgiving are often requested.

My major duty, and the one I take great joy in fulfilling, is to share the Good News of the Gospel message; to share it, especially with those who have not previously received it. Let me explain the reason you see the scripture verses lining the path to the Empty Cross. The purpose of this beautiful garden is not merely to let you enjoy major Christian art donated by three world class artists and marvel at the vision of Max and Sherry Greiner. Incidentally, the two of them are the major contributors of the art you will experience. I just told you what the purpose *is not*; this *is* the purpose: Max and Sherry's *vision and purpose is that this magnificent Cross, Garden and its art collection be the magnet that attracts larger and larger numbers of lonely, lost and suffering souls into an eternal relationship with their Savior.*

It is working!!! I and my brothers and sisters who are blessed to meet and visit with our guests see and hear evidence of its success each time we come to the Cross. Many

people are finding their way to a Home in Heaven during their visit to the Garden, If any of you are harboring a doubt about your final destination please let me know before you leave; I want to introduce you to Jesus; the Jesus who pointed out to Thomas and the others that He is; “the Way the Truth and the Life” the only way to an eternal relationship with the Father.

Getting back to the scriptures, a very fine Dentist, who is also an outstanding Bible student, (Doctor Robbie Carpenter) assembled the seventy seven scripture verses we will see as we stroll to the Empty Cross and make our way back to Jesus. The verses leading to the Empty Cross, the east side of the path, lead one to a better understanding of Jesus, the one the prophets of old foretold, and Jesus our Savior, who loved us enough to die for us. The scriptures on the west side provide insight into how one must behave once one has accepted Jesus as his Lord and Savior. You will see as you read these scriptures, *in whichever language is most comfortable for you*, that they are an outstanding teaching and learning tool.

As we continue our tour please do not lose sight of the primary purpose for the Garden and my primary role as a Chaplain. We want everyone who visits to be sure they have a home in heaven. That is why we ask the question of those of you who have been attending church since you were a child. How can one be sure?

Jesus brings us the New Covenant, and provides for our Salvation. If we want to “accept Jesus as Lord and Savior” we must accept what he taught. How can we acknowledge our acceptance? We must go to Him in prayer; a prayer which confirms our faith in who He is.

*The following is a sample prayer; you may use your own words; or you may use the prayer you find in The Empty cross.*

*Dear God I know I'm a sinner, I know I am not where I want to be, and I want your forgiveness! I believe that Jesus died on the cross to pay the price for my sins. I believe He was raised from the dead, He lives! Please wash me clean from all sin, shame, and guilt, come into my life to be my Lord and Savior. I ask these things in your name Jesus.*

*If you sincerely prayed this prayer or your own, expressing the same convictions you are justified by God's grace through your faith; you have begun your eternal relationship with God; His Spirit has taken up residence in your heart and your home in heaven is assured; these are promises of God; praise be to God, you are an adopted child of the Father.*

*As I pointed out; if any doubt lingers; pray for Salvation; your Loving Lord is anxious to hear from you. Rest assured He wants you to join the rest of the Born again Believers in His family.*

***Enjoy your time on the mountain; let us begin our tour.***

To all of you who may read this. I try to bring the pure message of the Bible and avoid doctrinal additions.

# SAMPLE TOUR GUIDE CHAPLAIN SCRIPT

by Max Greiner, Jr. (5/20/15)

*Since the available time, size and make-up of each group will vary, each Tour Guide Chaplain presentation will be different. On average, we can expect that a group will be at the cross for one to two hours. In most cases, time allowed for a Tour Presentation will be 20 to 40 minutes. The remainder of the time will be used by visitors to wander around, take photos, pray, ask questions and receive personal ministry. Therefore this Script is just one suggestion. Allow the Holy Spirit to guide you!*

Sample Presentation (45 minutes):

## I. INTRODUCTION

- A. Greetings and welcome to **The Coming King Sculpture Prayer Garden** in Kerrville, TX! I am one of your Tour Guide Chaplains. My name is\_\_\_\_\_.
- B. Today, we will start with a short presentation and then we will answer your questions.
- C. Your Tour Guides for today are wearing red aprons... because we are here to serve you, and God. We will be glad to pray for you at the end of this presentation, if that is your desire. TCKF Tour Guides assisting me today are: \_\_\_\_\_.
- D. First, you need to know that our temporary restrooms are over there, not fancy, but they work! One day when The Coming King Foundation raises the money to finish this garden there will be plenty of beautiful bathrooms!
- E. Therefore, we appreciate your prayers and donations! The Garden is being built on faith in God, without debt. TCKF is not affiliated with any church, denomination or ministry. Legally, TCKF is a non-profit 501c3 art museum that chooses to display uplifting, Christ-honoring artwork. All donations are tax deductible in the USA.
- F. TCKF is guided by volunteer Trustees. These volunteers are pastors, evangelists, artists, contractors and laymen from various Christian denominations, all of whom love Jesus Christ.
- G. Over \$2 million dollars have already been spent on the project to date.
- H. Plus, almost \$3 million dollars worth of contemporary Christian sculptures have been donated by three internationally collected Christian artists: Max Greiner, Jr., Beverly Paddleford and David Broussard.

- I. Finally, before you leave today, TCKF has lots of free "God Stuff" for you, including Bibles, brochures, "Cross Over Texas" car decals and a free audio CD with the story of the garden.

## II. GARDEN

- A. Now let me tell you about this amazing unfinished garden. Thousands of Christians believe you are standing on "Holy Ground."
- B. This garden is being built by **The Coming King Foundation** with the help of thousands of Christians across America, for the glory of God, so that millions of people can come to know the love of Jesus Christ. That is our purpose.
- C. This garden is unique in the entire world. This is a really big project birthed by the Holy Spirit on 12/9/01.
- D. As we know, our country and world really needs God's intervention.
- E. This garden is just one method God is using today to turn the hearts of people to Himself.
- F. There is a Site Plan (or map) of the entire 23 acre Garden on the sign right over there.
- G. As you can see, the garden is not finished yet. Thankfully, God uses unfinished things...and people! However, we will finish this garden one day! The Bible says God always finishes what He starts!
- H. The location of this garden is not an accident. God selected a location approximately halfway between the Pacific and Atlantic Oceans, on IH-10, in the center of Texas! It also is at the same latitude as southern Israel, at 30'03 degrees!
- I. We are on the top of a solid limestone and flint hill that looks like the Holy Land. You are standing 1,930' feet above sea level, or 170' above the interstate highway below.
- J. This garden is a "type" of last days Tabernacle, which was predicted in the Bible (Amos 9: 11-12 & Isaiah 2: 2-3). The entire Garden property could be considered the "Promised Land."
- K. The land down by IH-10 is the "Outer Court". The top of this mountain on this plateau is the "Inner Court". The 7' wide center space of this cross is the most holy place, or the "Holy of Holies".
- L. The massive sculpture you see is "**The Empty Cross**" by artist/evangelist Max Greiner, Jr. This Cor-ten steel cross we believe is the most symbolic cross sculpture in the world.
- M. In God's sovereignty, the cross-shaped garden is exactly twice the length of the original Tabernacle built by Moses and the artist/sculptor Bezalel (Exodus 31).

- N. In our high speed “microwave world”, the Gospel is be quickly communicated visually with monumental Christ-honoring sculptures.
- O. In addition, 77 Bible verses are engraved (in Spanish, English & German) on 16” Scripture Tiles, in a path that leads to the cross.
- P. The 300’ cross-shaped garden is exactly twice the size of the original Tabernacle of Moses, measured in Egyptian Cubits.
- Q. 42 Maple Trees line the cross-shape garden and are known as the “Found Maples”, as compared to the famous “Lost Maples State Park”.
- R. Over a dozen of monumental sculptures, worth over \$3,000,000 have been donated to this garden by three artist families, for God’s glory.
- S. Beverly Paddleford of Lander, WY donated **“Mary, Mother of Jesus”** located at the main entrance.
- T. David Broussard of Dallas, TX donated **“It Is Finished”**. This is the contemporary sculpture of three giant 11’ long nails at the bottom of the garden.
- U. All the other sculptures were created and donated by Max Greiner, Jr., President of TCKF. At the entrance is a bust of a warrior king, who is Jesus Christ, called **“The Coming King”**®. Max also created the bronze sculptures of **“Fisher Of Men”**®, **“The Great Commission”**® and **“Divine Servant”**®.
- V. **“The Empty Cross”** sculpture is also Greiner’s creation.
- W. Finally, at the bottom you will see a rock monument designed by Max (who has a degree in architecture from Texas A&M University) called **“Twelve Stones”**. This monument honors the first twelve families/foundations that donated the funds to make this garden possible.
- X. We believe the Kerrville garden is the “prototype” for many other evangelical gardens that will be built across the USA and world, to honor Jesus Christ.

### III. THE CROSS

- A. The seven story cross sculpture you see here is a “type” of New Testament “Ark of the Covenant”.
- B. It was erected on 7/27/10 after years of opposition, a 15 month lawsuit, and an IRS audit stimulated by false accusations of atheists and other opponents of the cross.
- C. The legal battle to raise this cross in 2009 and 2010 catapulted the project into national and international news. What Satan meant for evil, God used for good! As a result millions of people now know about the cross!

- D. *"The Empty Cross"* sculpture is unique in the entire world.
- E. We believe it is the most symbolic cross sculpture every made. The blood colored, Resurrection cross symbolizes the Door, the Way, the Narrow Gate, the Strong Tower, the Mighty Fortress that allows the Light of the World (Jesus Christ) to shine through.
- F. The massive 77'7" sculpture weighs approximately 70 tons, counting the steel in the foundation. The "skeleton" is made of structural Carbon Steel with a Cor-tin steel "skin" that "bleeds" a red/brown color. It never needs to be painted.
- G. People can actually enter the 7' wide center space of the cross.
- H. The cross "foot print" is square, like the Holy of Holies in the original Tabernacle and the Jewish Temple.
- I. The cross arms are 40' wide. Construction workers stood in the 7' wide space you see above you.
- J. The spikes you see on the top edges of the cross are actually "Bird Spikes", and remind us of the "Crown of Thorns".
- K. *"The Empty Cross"* sculpture represents the birth, life, death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. Jesus is not dead, He is alive and risen! And soon, He will be returning as The Coming King!
- L. This cross communicates the Resurrection, and the sacrifice Jesus made so we could all receive forgiveness from God for our sins.
- M. The open, empty design communicates that all people are welcome at the foot of the cross. The way is open to us, no matter our past sins.
- N. Christ's birth is also represented by this cross. At night a single light shines in the top of the cross, like the Star of Bethlehem, which announced the birth of the Jewish Messiah 2,000 years ago.
- O. Inside this cross are four panels or plaques. The first explains how anyone can enter Heaven, if they choose. This plaque explains the "Born Again" or "Salvation" experience. Salvation is a gift of God which cannot be earned by doing good things or being water baptized.
- P. Jesus does not reject people, they reject Him.
- Q. The second plaque explains how anyone can be supernaturally "Empowered" with the nine Gifts of the Holy Spirit (1Corinthians 12).
- R. The third plaque explains the Biblical way of receiving supernatural healing, physically and emotionally.
- S. The fourth and final plaque in the cross explains how anyone can receive miracles, signs & wonders.
- T. Lives of thousands of people have literally changed while praying inside this giant cross. Dozens of people have canceled suicide.
- U. This cross is only a piece of metal, however Jesus Christ is the doorway to joy in this life and Heaven. He is the way, the truth and the life. No man comes to the Father except through the Son.

- V. Finally, you will notice that right over there is a Video Camera filming us right now. LIVE Streaming Video is being directed to TCKF website 24/7, so Christians around the world can pray for the people they see standing in the center of this cross.

#### IV. THE HISTORY

- A. The idea for this cross and the garden was given by God to artist/evangelist, Max Greiner, Jr., in a "vision", after a stranger emailed the artist on 8/ 22/02.
- B. Marlon Quibodeaux from Beaumont, TX wrote the artist stating that God wanted him to create a giant 77'7" Resurrection cross over IH-10.
- C. Eight months earlier, on 12/9/01, another stranger named Dr. Mahesh Chavda, of North Carolina, prophesied at Cathedral of Praise church in Austin, TX that God was calling the artist/evangelist and his wife, Sherry, along with the help of other Christians, to restore the "last days" Tabernacle (Amos 9:11 & Isaiah 2:2).
- D. Confused by the two unexpected, modern day prophecies, Greiner prayed for understanding in August of 2002.
- E. To his surprise, Greiner received a vision of a giant hollow cross sculpture, and a 300' long cross-shaped garden decorated with monumental Christian bronze sculptures, and the Gospel engraved in multiple languages on a path leading to the cross. Then, Greiner saw cars backed up on a frontage road of an interstate highway, waiting to get into a free Sculpture Prayer Garden.
- F. Suddenly, Greiner had a vision from God, but no money, place or organization to build the Christ-honoring garden!
- G. On 12/11/03, Greiner was sitting at the intersection of Hwy 16 (Sidney Baker) and Loop 534 in Kerrville waiting for the light to change when the Holy Spirit spoke to Max's spirit and said: "LOOK UP, THIS IS THE LAND I WILL GIVE YOU!"
- H. Stunned, Greiner immediately tried to find out who owned the ideal 23 acres of land at the main entrance to the City of Kerrville.
- I. The raw land had been purchased in 1984 by a man from Pipe Creek, TX named Clifford Reed, purely as an investment. However, Reeh never once put the valuable land on the market in 21 years!
- J. Greiner contacted Reeh by phone and mail, stating God wanted to use his land to bring millions of souls to Jesus. In his letter and phone messages Greiner asked Reeh to give him the land worth millions of dollars! Reeh did not respond to Greiner's letters or phone calls.
- K. Then, to Greiner's surprise, on 4/24/04 Reeh contacted Greiner and agreed to meet at the land. To Greiner's amazement, he learned that

not only was Reeh a Christian, but he was an art collector. Then, Greiner learned Reeh was one of his art collectors who purchased his small Christian bronze "*Divine Servant*"® on 12/19/90.

- L. After Greiner shared his vision of the garden the men prayed.
- M. After praying with his wife, Dorothy, Reeh agreed to donate the 23 acres of valuable land worth millions of dollars to TCKF. Legal contracts were drawn.
- N. However, later Reeh called back and said he could not go through with the deal because his adult sons found out, and said the land was their inheritance. Clifford stated the sons would accept \$500,000 for the land. This was a great price, except Greiner and TCKF did not have \$500,000!
- O. Disappointed, Max reported Reeh's change of heart to the Trustees. (Max and Sherry formed the 501c3 organization on 5/6/04, with five other Christian leaders: Pastor Jack Rothenflue, Pastor David Danielson, Worship Pastor, Becky Jons and accountants, Randy and Nancy Scroggins.)
- P. The seven Trustees, after praying, voted unanimously to believe that God would give them the \$500,000 needed. They also agreed TCKF would not borrow money, or hire professional fund raisers. If God wanted this garden, He would have to pay for it!
- Q. By the grace of God, the Greiners were able to make the largest cash donation of their lives, but it was not enough to purchase the land from Reeh.
- R. After a month of fundraising efforts, only enough money was raised to pay for the printing and postage!
- S. With time running out on the contract between TCKF and Reeh, on 9/16/05, 19 Christians went out to the land to pray. They asked God to give them the land, as He promised. They asked God for the money and a million souls for Jesus.
- T. Greiner then planted a small 17" wooden cross, made from cedar branches on the property, near this spot where you are standing today. The cross was anointed with oil and water from Israel.
- U. When the cross was planted in the ground, a 3" scorpion appeared and charged the cross. Sherry Greiner crushed the symbol of Satan under her foot.
- V. Suddenly, the sky filled with a dozen wild Northern Harrier Hawks. (Eagles, hawks and doves are symbols of God's kingdom.)
- W. Little did the Christians know, but one of the people who came that day put out a "fleece". Hershel Reid, a Greiner art collector, asked God to put a hawk in the sky if his family was to buy the land for the

garden. When Reid opened his eyes from prayer, the sky was full of wild hawks!

- X. The next day Reid gave TCKF \$500,000, which he did through his family foundation!
- Y. The details of this miracle and many others are on the TCKF website. They are also recounted on the free audio CD which is available to you today.

## V. MIRACLES, SIGNS & WONDERS AT THE CROSS!

- A. God has made His presence known repeatedly here at the Kerrville garden. In addition to Salvations and Baptisms of power, you may have heard about the many genuine, Biblical type miracles that have occurred here. These have been covered by the news reporters from Associated Press, CBS, ABC, NBC, FOX and the Christian TV networks.
- B. The miracles have included supernatural healings and signs and wonders.
- C. After Prayer Intercessors claimed the land for God's King, contractor Basil McKay reported that the snakes left the mountain, and a pure white dove descended in front of their operating heavy equipment!
- D. Over a thousand people have witnessed the supernatural appearance of what we believe is the visible Shekinah Glory of God (Ex 34:29). It looks like fine glitter that forms on the faces, hands, clothing and Bibles of visitors to the garden, as they pray. (It is easy to see in bright sunlight or under the light of the cross at night.) You may be seeing these tiny particles forming on your hands now, as you hear this testimony.
- E. In addition, hundreds of people have taken flash photographs of thousands of balls of light on the property and around the cross. Humanoid angelic figures have been photographed, in addition to thousands of Angel Orbs. This angel form was described thousands of years ago by the Jewish Prophet, Ezekiel (Ezk 1:15-22).
- F. On 9/1/11, five people, including the 911 Emergency Operator witnessed a white vertical column of smoke for 40 minutes behind the cross. It was viewed from the LIVE video camera on the TCKF website. Fire trucks were dispatched but there was no fire!

- G. In January of 2015 “Living Water” was discovered under the giant cross. The gushing water could actually be heard from the top of the well head, to the amazement of the driller and pump company.
- H. All these supernatural Holy Spirit manifestations are explained on the TCKF website: [www.thecomingkingfoundation.org](http://www.thecomingkingfoundation.org)
- I. Finally, if you would like to receive the free TCKF email newsletter (“**FIRE ON THE MOUNTAIN**”) to keep up with the ongoing miracles at this garden, please fill out our Comment Cards on the table with the free TCKF resources.

- B. **GOD, PLEASE TAKE ME HEAVEN WHEN I DIE! I DON’T WANT TO SPEND ETERNITY IN HELL. I GIVE MY LIFE AND ALL MY PROBLEMS TO YOU RIGHT NOW! JESUS CHRIST, I CONFESS THAT I AM A SINNER AND THAT I NEED A SAVIOR. PLEASE FORGIVE ME OF ALL MY SINS. MAKE ME A NEW CREATION. FILL ME WITH YOUR HOLY SPIRIT. THANK YOU FOR SAVING ME CLEANSING ME AND GIVING ME A HOME IN HEAVEN. I ACCEPT YOUR FREE GIFT OF SALVATION BECAUSE OF WHAT YOU DID FOR ME ON THE CROSS 2000 YEARS AGO. GOD MAKE ME THE PERSON YOU WANT ME TO BE! IN THE NAME OF JESUS CHRIST I PRAY. AMEN!**
- C. If you just prayed with sincerity, you are now what the Bible calls “**Born-Again**”. You have just moved from “religion to relationship” with God. You’re now a genuine Christian, sanctified by the shed blood of Jesus! The good “**Fruit of the Spirit**” listed in Galatians 5:22 will start to manifest in your life. Other will see the changes in your life.
- D. If you just prayed to receive Jesus Christ as your LORD and Savior, would you please raise your hand now? (Jesus said if you will NOT

acknowledge Him before man, He will NOT acknowledge you before the Father in Heaven.) Therefore, please acknowledge Jesus now and thank God by waving your hand. Thank you!

- E. But, there's more! For all Born-Again Christians, God has some great Gifts He wants to give you now! These are supernatural, miracle Gifts which will give you the power to serve God and your fellowman to the utmost degree. All Christians need these wonderful Gifts operating in their lives. If you want everything God has for you to better serve Him, please pray this empowering prayer with me:
- F. ***GOD, IN THE NAME OF JESUS CHRIST, I ASK YOU TO RELEASE THE GIFTS OF THE HOLY SPIRIT IN MY LIFE SO I CAN MOST EFFECTIVELY SERVE YOU. THE BIBLE SAYS YOU ONLY GIVE GOOD GIFTS TO YOUR CHILDREN, SO I ASK THAT YOU RELEASE THESE SUPERNATURAL GIFTS OF THE HOLY SPIRIT, AT THIS MOMENT. I RENOUNCE ANY EVIL, CURSES AND SIN IN MY LIFE. BAPTIZE ME WITH FIRE AND POWER! MAKE ME A PRAYER WARRIOR FOR YOUR KINGDOM! THANK YOU FOR BLESSING ME WITH THE GIFTS OF THE HOLY SPIRIT, LISTED IN 1 CORINTHIANS 12. I PROMISE TO ALWAYS GIVE YOU THE GLORY FOR ANY MIRACLES YOU WORK IN MY LIFE. THANK YOU HOLY SPIRIT FOR ALL YOU ARE ABOUT TO DO IN MY LIFE. IN THE MIGHTY NAME OF JESUS CHRIST I PRAY, AMEN!***
- G. If you prayed that prayer with sincerity, then you have just been **"Empowered"** or **"Baptized in the Holy Spirit"** by Jesus!
- H. You can now ask for and expect miracles in your life, and in the lives of others.
- I. Some churches have a name for this experience, others do not.
- J. This empowering experience is the "Promise of the Father" mentioned in the Book of Acts and other places! 2000 year ago this power baptism turned normal fishermen into world changers!
- K. If you just prayed that prayer with me for the first time, please wave your hand in the air now so I can see God's newest Prayer Warriors!
- L. You are in for a Holy Spirit adventure! The Bible says signs & wonders will follow those who believe. Your prayers in the name of Jesus can even heal the sick!
- M. Now, read the entire Bible starting with the New Testament, pray, worship God, serve others, give, and join a good Bible believing church!
- N. The Bible says God is the same yesterday, today and forever! If He ever worked miracles on this earth, He still does. If He ever empowered people to do miraculous works, He still does!

- O. Your love for God, His Word, His miracles and His people will now dramatically increase in your life. People will take notice!
- P. Also, get Water Baptized at your church, as a “public profession” of your faith.
- Q. Finally, obey the still small voice of the Holy Spirit. He will speak to your spirit every day, if you seek Him.

## VIII. FINAL BLESSING

- A. Now, let me close this presentation with a prayer of blessing over each person here:
  - B. GOD, IN THE NAME OF JESUS, I THANK YOU FOR WHAT YOU HAVE DONE HERE TODAY. I PRAY THAT YOU BLESS, PROTECT, SAVE, EMPOWER, HEAL, DELIVER AND PROPSEER EACH PERSON SO THEY CAN WALK IN THE DESTINY YOU HAVE FOR THEM. MAY THEY NEVER FORGET THAT YOU TOUCHED THEM ON THIS MOUNTAIN, ON THIS DAY. IN THE MIGHTY NAME OF JESUS CHRIST, AMEN!!!***
