



FOUND MAPLES

Near Vanderpool in the Texas Hill Country, 52 miles away southwest of Kerrville, is one of the most popular parks in Texas called "Lost Maples State Natural Area". Approximately 200,000 people a year visit the wilderness area to see a small stand Bigtooth Maple trees. God told TCKF founder and artist, Max Greiner, Jr. to plant 50 Maple trees at The Coming King Sculpture Prayer Garden and name them the "Found Maples". Christians, Bryan and Stacie Hutzler, owners of Love Creek Orchards in Medina, TX donated the 42 Maple trees that line the 300' cross-shaped garden.



2020 PRAYER WISH LIST

PROPERTY ENTRANCE SIGN

(\$1200 onetime expense) – A beautiful new sign is needed. The current sign is 14 years old!

TEMPORARY GIFT SHOP

(\$70,000 onetime expense) – A temporary Gift Shop Gallery is needed at the bottom of the garden near IH-10 far away from the "Holy Ground" at the top of the mountain. The artwork and gift lines of the three donor artists, Beverly Paddleford, David Broussard and Max Greiner, Jr. will be available to tourists for inspiration and as souvenirs. Sales will provide TCKF with a continuous income stream to fund improvements and the ongoing maintenance of the garden. These three artists have already donated millions of dollars' worth of their art to God's garden.

TEN COMMANDMENTS MONUMENT

(\$100,000 onetime expense) – A majestic "Lion Of Judah"™ life-size bronze sculpture has been donated by Max and Sherry Greiner and others. The statue will rest upon a massive Ten Commandments Monument in the circular "Lion Of Judah Fortress" which overlooks Kerrville and IH-10. Funds are needed now to cast the large bronze Scripture Plates that will surround the monument.

EXERCISE TRAIL & PICNIC AREA

(\$45,000 onetime expense) – A 150 yard long shaded exercise trail, with picnic tables, is planned for the green area just below the upper parking lot. This crushed granite path will connect to the upper and lower parking lots via three sets of concrete steps.





received Jesus as Lord and Savior at that moment. Afterwards I was honored to Baptize him in the Holy Spirit.

Then he wanted to be Water Baptized at The Coming King fountain. The wayfarer came out

of the Living Water and said: "What just happened? My pain is gone!!!

I told him, "You know!" He raised his arms and thanked God for his miracle and blessing! The father made his bus connection and returned to his family a New Man!

Thank you Jesus! My prayer for the stranger was answered in a short time!

TCKF TOUR GUIDE CHAPLAINS

When guests arrive at the 24.5acre Sculpture Prayer Garden in Kerrville for the first time, most are surprised and amazed. Virtually everyone perceives something holy about the mountain, though they may not be able to explain their feelings. Sometimes guests come in groups and other times they are alone. Many people are in need and others are just sightseeing. Some visitors want to be alone with God while others are hoping to receive

prayer from a follower of Jesus Christ. The needs of visitors are diverse.

Shortly after "The Empty Cross" 77'7" steel sculpture was erected in July of 2010, TCKF quickly realized that the Holy

Spirit wanted Believers to assist Him at times in doing ministry and serving sojourners. Though the evangelistic art garden was designed by artist evangelist Max Greiner, Jr. to be "self-service", everyone quickly recognized the need for volunteer Chaplains and Tour Guides. It was decided that these two roles would be combined to best serve the people. These special Christian volunteers would be called Tour Guide Chaplains.

1. Why are Tour Guide Chaplains needed?

The Holy Spirit draws visitors to "The Empty Cross", who have needs for more of Jesus Christ in their lives. The Holy Spirit leads by lighting a spark in visitors' hearts. God also calls some Christians to serve as Tour Guide Chaplains at the Tabernacle Garden, to fan the flame of the Holy Spirit's FIRE, for the benefit of each visitor and the glory of the Lord.

"THE RED APRON SYMBOLIZES CHRIST'S BLOOD AND OUR SERVICE TO THE ONES SEEKING HIM. 2. What do Tour Guide Chaplains Do? Tour Guide Chaplains serve our Father in Heaven and His children. They provide tours, answer questions and pray. They provide insights

about garden history, artwork, symbolism and share personal testimonies. These genuine Christians can also lead visitors to a saving relationship with Jesus Christ and can perform Water Baptisms. These men and women also encourage Born-again believers to be fully empowered through the "Baptism of the Holy Spirit" experience.

Tour Guide Chaplains also listen and lead visitors in prayers for forgiveness of family members,

TCKF TOUR GUIDE CHAPLAINS

The Coming King Foundation has trained and certified selected Tour Guide Chaplains to serve guests who visit The Coming King Sculpture Prayer Garden in Kerrville, TX. These volunteers, from different Christian denominations, are trained to function as both tour guides, and Christian chaplains. All TCKF Tour Guide Chaplains know the basic story of the garden and the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

The red servant's aprons are presented to qualifying candidates upon completion of their basic training. Each new Tour Guide Chaplain is set in place by TCKF Trustees and the TCKF Fire Marshalls, who lead this group, who are referred to as the "TCKF Volunteer Fire Department". These Christian volunteers carry the love and fire of God in their bones and on their heads!
