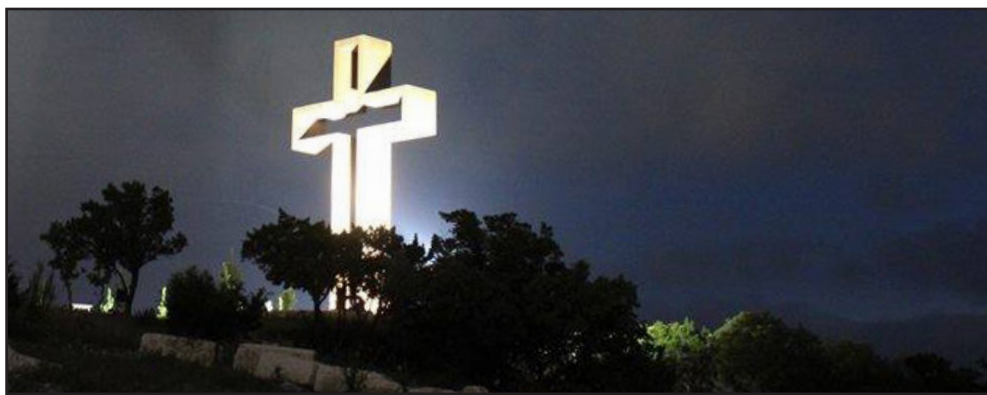

2020 PRAYER WISH LIST

FINISH INTERIOR OF GIFT SHOP

Only the exterior of the new Gift Shop is finished, so it will still need flooring, sheetrock, light fixtures, etc. Max is working on the floor plan now for our 16'x 40' Gift Shop building, with an ADA accessible restroom and an inventory storage room. We are hoping to have this available for customers by Christmas.

SECURITY

Upgrade existing security cameras (\$3,000) and add privacy fence at the back of the property (\$5,000)

TEN COMMANDMENTS MONUMENT

(\$100,000 onetime expense) – A majestic "Lion Of Judah"™ life-size bronze sculpture has been donated by Max and Sherry Greiner and others. The

statue will rest upon a massive Ten Commandments Monument in the circular "Lion Of Judah Fortress" which overlooks Kerrville and IH-10. Funds are needed now to cast the large bronze Scripture Plates that will surround the monument.

PRAYER BENCHES

(\$4,250) New Prayer Benches need to be added between the "Hope" sculpture and the "Star of David" sculpture on the western prayer path.

EXERCISE TRAIL & PICNIC AREA

(\$45,000 onetime expense) – A 150 yard long shaded exercise trail, with picnic tables, is planned for the green area just below the upper parking lot. This crushed granite path will connect to the upper and lower parking lots via three sets of concrete steps.

LION OF JUDAH – JERUSALEM

JERUSALEM, ISRAEL — Predicted rains held back Tuesday morning, May 5, 2020 so a magnificent new monumental bronze sculpture named the “LION OF JUDAH” could be installed in the heart of Jerusalem. The massive 11’ long statue was permanently placed in Bloomfield Park, located between the Old City and new Jerusalem, behind the King David Hotel, in sight of Mount Zion and the Jaffa Gate. Amos Cohen, who is responsible for all 174 public sculptures in the city of Jerusalem said on Tuesday:

“This the most beautiful of all the pieces of art we have in the city because it is a lion and the symbol of the city of Jerusalem. It means more to me than any other piece of art in the city ... my heart is filled right now. I love the Christian community. They do so much for the city of Jerusalem, and they do so much for the State of Israel and my heart is with you in friendship and thank you.”

The official dedication of the sculpture is tentatively planned for the fall of 2020. Max says, “As promised, I will be creating a special art gift to send to all donors who gave \$1,000 or more to make this gift of love possible.

LION OF JUDAH – KERRVILLE



Max says, "Around the circle, facing the Lion, I believe the Holy Spirit told me to place 35 plaques with quotes by prominent people, who freely pointed to Jesus Christ, the Bible and Christianity. We will prayerfully select the best quotes and will use the special 12" black metal plaque material. These will be attached to a 16" ceramic tile and the tile will be concreted into the limestone. An area at the bottom of each plaque will be reserved for the name of the Donor/Sponsor, in a different type font." (More info will be provided separately.)



It is our hope that the "Artist Copy" bronze lion casting will be mounted to its limestone base at the Kerrville Garden in late August. Owners of EAGLE BRONZE, Monte and Beverly Paddleford will be installing the sculpture in the "LION OF JUDAH FORTRESS" and speaking at our Dedication Service. The Bronze 10 Commandments Plaques are still in the design process. We are hoping to have them ready to install on the base beneath the Lion by year-end.



GARDENING AT THE CROSS CULTIVATES SPIRITUAL LESSONS

A TIME TO SOW — A TIME TO BLOOM!

The Bible is full of references to sowing, the fun part of gardening. And waiting, the hard part. Last November, Red corn poppy seeds and Rocket larkspurs were scattered throughout God's Garden. Six months later, bright red, white, pink and purple blooms displayed their splendor, April to July. Even better, the seeds produced are expected to make an annual show.

LIVING SYMBOLS OF JESUS' CULTURE

The fig tree, a metaphor for the nation of Israel, represents spiritual and physical health. Our fig tree is only two feet tall just now, so its roots can find sure and deep footing in this rocky Hill Country soil. With TLC this sapling will grow fruitful in just a few years.

The olive tree symbolizes peace and blessing for mankind. Olive oil is a carrier of aromatic spices in the holy anointing oil of Zechariah 4. Throughout scripture olive oil represents the presence of the Holy Spirit. Our Arbequina olive, planted this spring, will spread roots this year but next year the young tree will begin to grow and be pruned slightly.

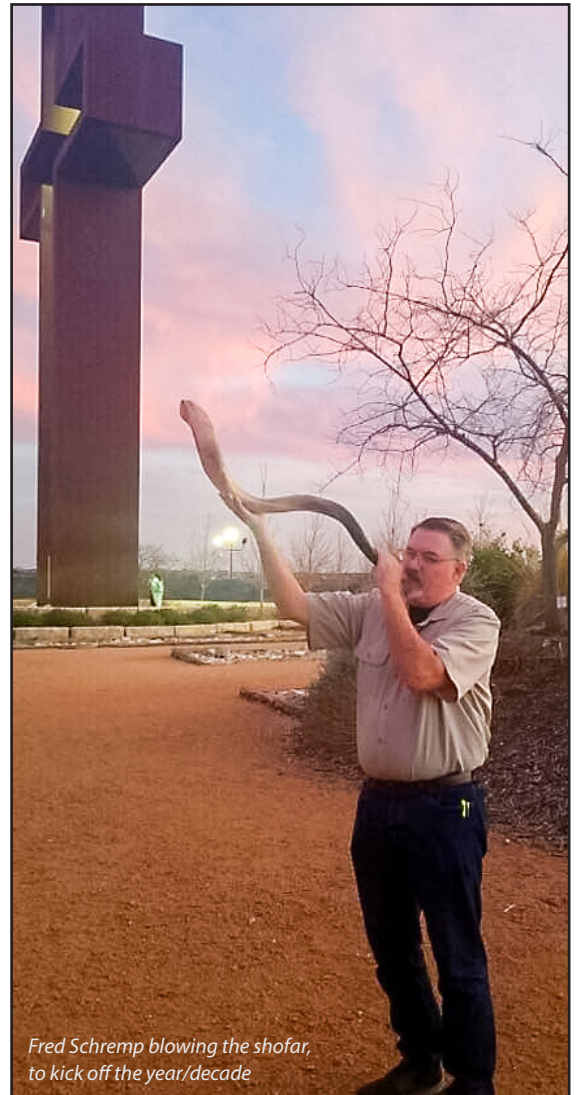
2020 Kick-Off We started the new year with prayer, proclaiming the Word of God and with great expectations for what God would do in 2020.

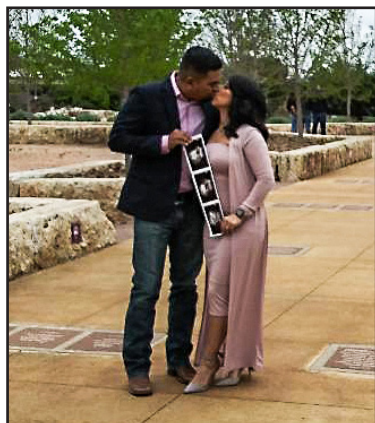

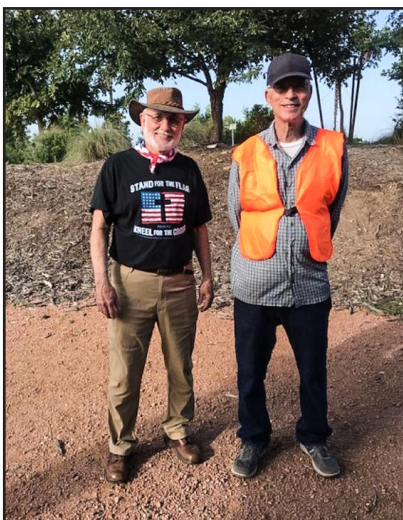

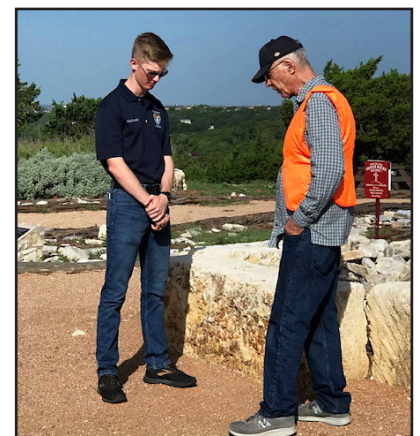
