

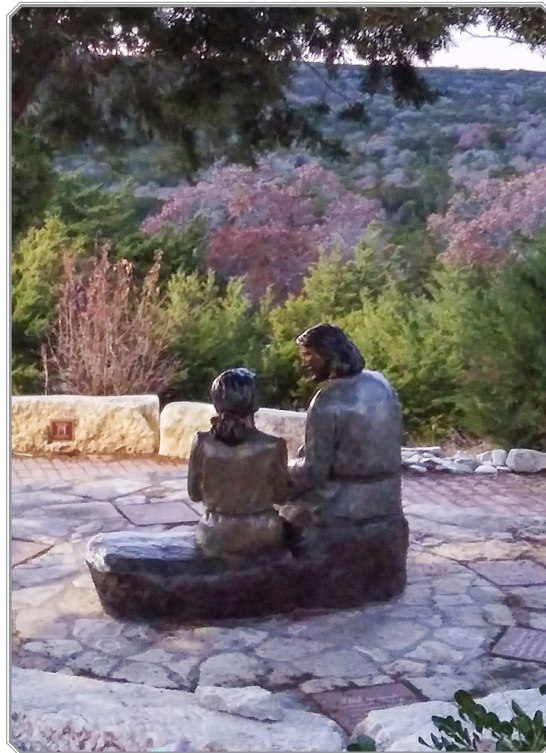

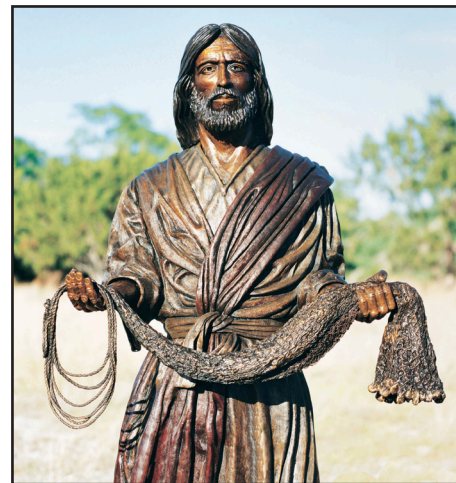

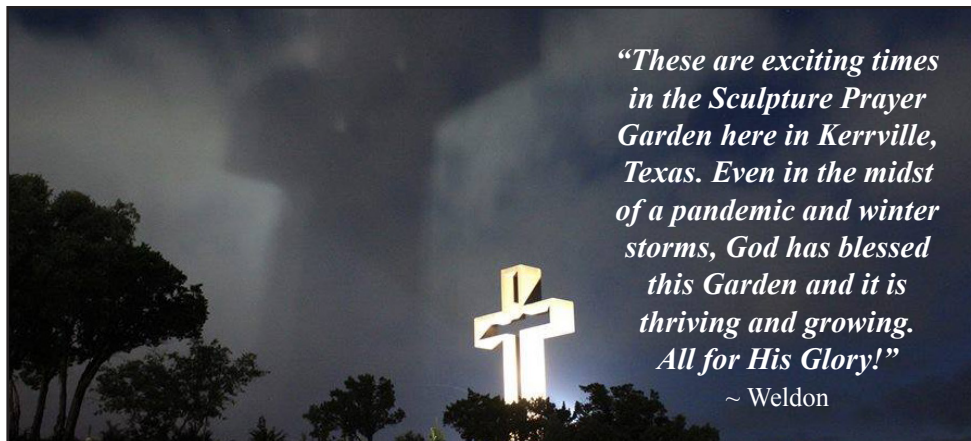

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

TIME TO PUT ON THE FULL ARMOR OF GOD

One of my passions and great joys is to serve as a Tour Guide Chaplain, here at The Coming King Foundation. I have the unique opportunity to visit with and minister to people from all of Texas and from around the world. Many visitors tell me they are at peace, blessed, refreshed, and have a renewed sense of faith in the presence of the LORD in His garden.

The LORD is our Hope and, with His Sword of the Spirit, the Word of God and His armor, we come to the Empty Cross and stand against all confusion in the world around us. The Empty Cross stands as a beacon of Light in the midst of darkness and doubt.

It is with great thankfulness that we present the following Project Updates:

COMPLETED PROJECTS:

Front entrance – We now have beautiful stones and plants to give a Hill Country Texas grand entrance as you enter the property. Several other areas will be beautified with additional stone blocks around the front entrance. (Stones donated from Weldon and Esther Baker's Triangle L. Ranch. Plants and stone placement compliments of Billy Long from Gardens on the Ridge.)

A privacy/security fence has been added behind the restrooms to separate work areas from public area. It is both practical and beautiful. (Juan Escheverria Construction)

24-hour worship around the Cross – upgraded six-speaker system

PROJECTS ESTIMATED FOR MARCH COMPLETION:

Storm repair and restroom maintenance – Repairs to the fountain at the entry and to the restrooms are complete. Water has been restored to all locations. However, repairs to the baptism fountain beneath The Coming King sculpture make take longer to complete. (Buddy Bell)

Limestone Block Security Wall - Large limestone blocks have been acquired (due to an anonymous donor) to add security on the South border of the Garden by installing a 2-block high limestone wall. (Edmund Jenke Inc.)

An additional security wall is being added to the back of the property. (Juan Escheverria Construction)

New prayer benches – An additional 41 prayer benches are being added along the walkway between the "Hope" and "One Nation Under God" (The Star of David) sculptures. (Edmund Jenke Inc.)

Security – Additional fire and security measures for both the Gift Shop and the TCKF office are being installed and are expected to be complete before the Gift Shop is open for the public.

The Garden Gift Shop is steadily being worked on, thanks to all of our donors who made this possible. See separate article on this.

PROJECTS ESTIMATED FOR APRIL COMPLETION:

Gift Shop Parking lot & ground leveling. Partially complete, timing to be determined after completion of projects listed above.

PENDING:

Paver stones to complete the front entrance

Directional billboard – type sign (from I-10) on the side of the Gift Shop

Plug-in stations for electric cars (in the parking lot)

PAVERS

Order a concrete Paver for yourself, your church, your business or as meaningful gifts for others! These concrete Pavers (priced from \$50 to \$1,000) will be on permanent display in The Coming King Sculpture Prayer Garden in Kerrville, TX forever. Pavers can be custom engraved and will be placed in the pathways and gardens in the order they are received. These lasting memorials are a wonderful way to honor a person, family or institution.

PRAYER BENCHES

Dedicate a \$777.00 Prayer Bench to a loved one, family, friends, spiritual mentors, your church, your pastor, your priest or the LORD. Hundreds of 5' long, massive, 1.25 ton stone blocks surround the 300' long cross-shaped garden, at the top of the mountain. Each rugged stone block functions as a bench for visitors. A personalized, 6" x 6" metal plaque is attached to an 8" x 8" paver block, which is then permanently inserted into the limestone block. Depending on the amount of text on the custom plaque, there may be room for one, 2 1/4" x 3" color photograph.

PICNIC AREA WALKING PATHS

Create walking trail with rest areas and picnic tables using crushed granite and pavers in green area (\$10,000)

CONCRETE STEPS

Concrete steps are needed to connect the upper area to the lower parking lot and to the walking paths (estimate \$80,000)

AMPHITHEATER

TCKF hopes to build a beautiful amphitheater that can be used for outdoor events. This area will be located at the bottom of the garden.

EQUIPMENT

Donation of a utility truck or Mule is needed to allow travel around the garden and for landscape use. TCKF is also in need of a trailer.

SOFT OPENING

LORD willing, we hope to get the store open to the public in early April. PRAY. We will do a formal "OPENING" later, once all the systems are working right. We will try to get the Paddlefords and Broussards down for this event.

CONSTRUCTION

The City of Kerrville should be inspecting the store electrical work the week of March 8. Then we can install the insulation followed by the sheet rock/ dry wall. The walls will be painted and the light fixtures and fans will be installed. We also need to install the flooring and toilet fixtures. Art Lenard and Buddy Bell will be figuring out the timing of the installations.

CABINETS

The cabinets that will support the sculptures and store the product inventory are at HOME DEPOT and are waiting for us in their warehouse. Once these are placed, Max will install the art on top of the cabinets and on the walls.

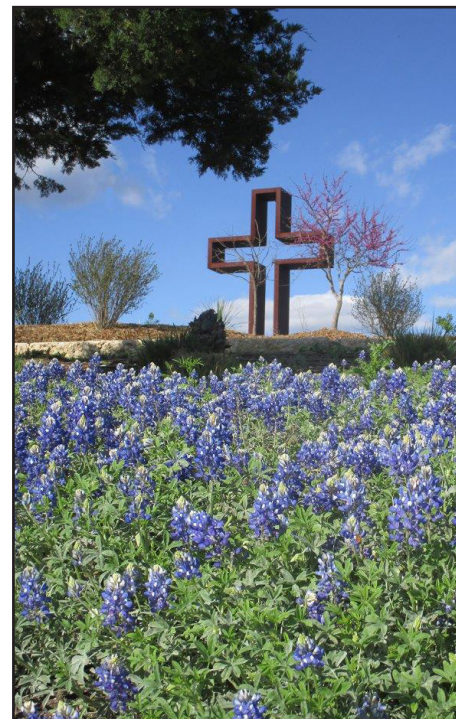

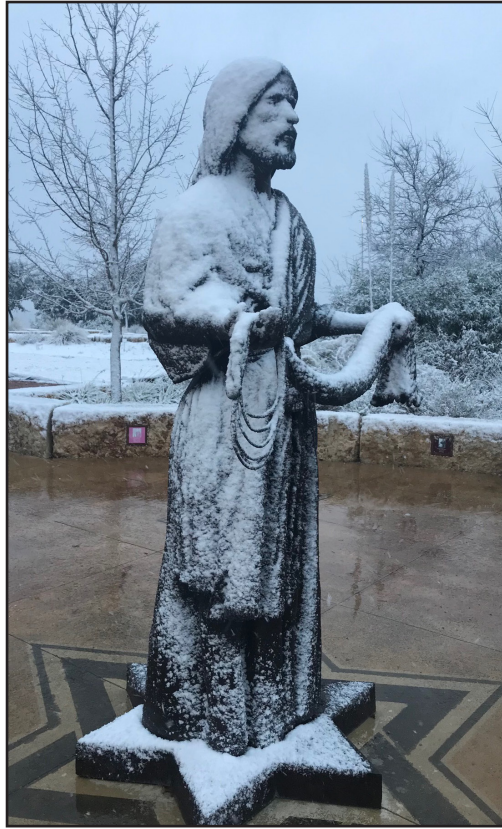
