Max Greiner, Jr. was made in the USA... in 1951. The artist was reared in the Lone Star State of Texas, knowing from age seven that he was gifted by God to be a visual artist. Trained as an architect at Texas A&M University, Greiner graduated in 1974 in the top of his design class. In 1975, Max married his wife, Sherry. The couple started their own art design business in the spring of 1978, in the Piney Woods of southeast Texas. Today, the couple lives in a creative, passive-solar studio/home designed by Max, on a 126-acre ranch, in the heart of the Texas Hill Country.

Greiner has been called a "Renaissance Man" by many. His work includes drawings, paintings, sculpture, jewelry, architecture, landscape architecture, interior design, photography, graphic art, art products and websites. He also is a published author, inspirational public speaker, avid archer and lover of God's creation and people.

Greiner's original Copyrighted and Trademarked artwork ranges in price from \$2 to over two million dollars. His work is collected in all 50 states and almost one hundred countries. People who have owned Max's artwork include US Presidents, Senators, Representatives, Governors and the stars of business, film, TV, radio, sports, music and religion. These include Pope John Paul II, Dr. Billy Graham and President George W. Bush.

All of Max's bronze, steel and stone monumental sculptures can be viewed at The Coming King Sculpture Prayer Garden, on IH-10 in Kerrville, Texas. The 24.5-acre spiritual art park was designed by Greiner. It features world-class landscaping and donated sculptures from three American artists. In July of 2022, leading travel website, Trip Advisor, designated The Coming King Sculpture Prayer Garden in the top 10% of all tourist attractions worldwide.
