CHAIRMAN'S CHALLENGE:

Throughout world history, God has used supernatural manifestations to draw people to Himself.

Thousands of years ago, a lone burning bush got the attention of Moses. The world has never been the same since. By the grace of God, The Coming King Sculpture Prayer Garden has been the site of dramatic miracles which have literally been witnessed by

thousands of people from around the world. The word is out! The top travel website on the planet, Trip Advisor, designated the art park in the top 10% of tourist attractions worldwide! And, more glory is coming to God's "Garden Tabernacle!"

The miracles actually began in December of 2001 with an "out-of-the-blue" prophecy by a stranger, Dr. Mahesh Chavda, who proclaimed publicly that we would be "involved in the restoration of the Tabernacle of David." Twenty-two years and thousands of miracles later, our story has been documented in books, magazines, newsletters, websites, social media, radio and TV programs. The Holy Spirit miracles are so numerous that visitors from

over one hundred nations have traveled to the Texas Hill Country to meet with God on this mountain.

In the coming months, God is giving The Coming King Foundation (TCKF) another incredible endorsement which is drawing the attention of believers and non-believers worldwide. Hundreds of thousands of tourists will soon stream into our small city to personally witness two rare astronomical events. The 1,930' high garden (located right on IH-10) will be one of the premier places in the world to view these rare celestial occurrences. Secular media has named these heavenly moments (which are occurring only six months apart) the "Great American Eclipses."

The paths of the two spectacular solar eclipses are intersecting right over Kerrville, Texas, right above "The Empty Cross" and The Coming King Sculpture Prayer Garden! On October 14, 2023 (my wife Sherry's birthday), an Annular Eclipse will occur at 11:41 a.m., lasting 4 minutes 56 seconds in duration, the longest anywhere. This eclipse is called the "Ring of Fire" because a dazzling "crown" will be observed since the moon will appear to be smaller inside the sun. Then, six months later, on April 8, 2024 at 1:27 p.m., a Total Eclipse of the sun will occur in Kerrville. This time, the moon will appear larger than the

NAMES OF GOD – Building an Altar to the Lord



Have you been to the Garden recently and wondered about the wall behind the Empty Cross?

We are excited to announce that TCKF is working on building a Names of God wall, which will be our "Altar to the Lord" just behind the Cross!

All throughout Scripture, when someone encountered the Lord in a specific way, they would honor the Lord by building an altar to Him and then worshiping Him. It began with Abram, then Isaac, and Moses. In Exodus 20:22-25. "The Lord told Moses to build my altar wherever I cause My Name to be remembered, and I will come to you and bless you." Joshua later renewed The Lord's covenant by building an altar to the Lord, as did Gideon, Samuel, Saul, David and Solomon. And finally, in the midst of oppression and great darkness in the land, the prophet Elijah emerged in his day and took a stand and rebuilt the altar to the Lord that had been torn down.

Similarly, in America, beginning in the 1960's, a movement began to take God out of our schools, our government buildings, and public places that once honored God in our nation. On January 12, 2023, TCKF voted unanimously to "build" an altar to the Lord and make this a monument that will forever honor and declare God's Holy Names!

Max Greiner crafted a model replica to cast the vision of what the wall will one day look like. The speed with which we are able to complete this wall depends entirely on donations.

IS JESUS GOD?

Is Jesus really God? The short answer is YES! This is proven in Scripture and by the testimony of Christians through all the centuries, including the apostle Thomas one week after Jesus' Resurrection. Thomas said to Jesus, "My Lord and my God." (John 20:28). But most importantly, Jesus states that Himself, "I and the Father are one." (John 10:30). The very reason Jesus was killed was because He not only made that claim, but He only did what He saw God do, particularly forgiving sins. We can forgive others' sins against us, but Jesus acted as if every sin was an affront to Him, and He readily forgave those sins that one person did to another person (Mark 2:7), "Why does this fellow talk like that? He's blaspheming! Who can forgive sins but God alone!" Indeed, only God can forgive sins!

Let's go a little deeper and start at the beginning. For thousands of years, the people of God have known that God is one. The core belief of the Jewish people is found in Deuteronomy 6:4-5, "The Lord our God, the Lord is one. You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might." And this is stated clearly not only in the Hebrew Scriptures of the Old Testament, but in the New Testament as well. "There is no God but one" (1 Cor. 8:4), and "There is only one God..." (1 Tim. 2:5).

And yet, even in the first chapter of the Bible, Genesis 1, we can see that the one God is a plurality. There is diversity within this unity. This is found even in the name of God used, Elohim, which is the plural form of El. Christians can see that the "Three-in-One" God was clearly indicated, with verse 1 referring to the Father (In the beginning, God/ Elohim), verse 2 the Holy Spirit, (and the Spirit of God was hovering over the waters), and verse 26 the Son, then let us make man in our image.

Genesis 1:26 reminds us that although we sometimes tend to think of the Father as the Creator, the Son as the Redeemer/Savior, and the Holy Spirit as the Strengtheners/ Sanctifier, this is not quite accurate. While it is certainly true

that each Person of the one Godhead has an emphasis, a particular way of commonly acting, all three Persons of God share all the "Trinity" attributes of the others.

The Father is also the Savior/Deliverer/Redeemer, which we can see clearly at the Red Sea deliverance of the Hebrews from slavery in Egypt. The Son is also the Creator, which is stated in several places in the Bible, including not only in Genesis 1:26, but even more clearly in John 1:10, "He was in the world, and the world was made through Him." And in Revelation 4:11, in the hymn to Jesus, "You created all things, and by your will they existed and were created." Similarly, the Holy Spirit is not just a force and influencer, but a "Divine Person." The Holy Spirit is not just the Spirit of God, but God the Spirit. The Spirit is the Divine Person whom Jesus sent to be with us after his Resurrection and Ascension. Jesus said, "you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you." (Acts 1:8) "He will teach you all things" (John 14:26). The Holy Spirit is not just a vague force, but the Teacher.

The point is that all three Persons of the Triune God are clearly called God in the New Testament. God the Father in Galatians 1:1; God the Son in John 20 (My Lord and my God); God the Holy Spirit in 1 Corinthians 1:10, where the Holy Spirit is regarded as God Himself, present with His people.

God is described in the Bible as One in Essence, in Three Persons. This is a perfect unity of love, a divine community of one, bound together by infinite love for each other. It is a love so strong and powerful that it reaches out even to us today, and to all creation forever. This is the experience of the Christian believer. We meet God directly in Jesus, and discern that God is truly present as the Son, the eternal Word of God. And we also meet God as the Father who sends the Son. And we experience God as the Holy Spirit, opening our hearts and minds in faith, and living within us. Yet it is the same God who is present throughout. One God! Praise Him, Lord of ALL!





GOD IS FOR US

How do you serve in the Garden? My role is to be there for Max. In 2001, Dr. Mahesh Chavda gave the prophetic word to Max, saying that Max would make an end-time tabernacle for the Lord. Since then, until now, Max has stayed with this “vision,” and I have been by his side the whole way. It’s been tough; we’ve been under attack. At times it seemed like everything was falling apart, but with God, we’ve been able to do what God wanted done in Kerrville.

Where are you from? I was born in Beaumont, TX, but moved to Port Arthur when I was two and grew up there.

How did you meet Jesus? Growing up I attended Sunday school, Church, and every Vacation Bible School, won ribbons for memorizing Scripture, but I did not have a relationship with Jesus. Every three months a new pastor would rotate through our church, but no one ever gave an altar call. Then one day, when I was about 14 years old, a new pastor came to the church. He spoke in a way I’d never heard before. Something was different and when he was done speaking, he invited us to come to the altar and give our life to Christ! I went right up. I knew something was different and I wanted what he had, a relationship with Jesus!

How did you find the Garden? Max, my husband, built the Garden. I’ve been by his side the whole way and I am so grateful that many others came alongside him and his “mission” to get this Garden done for Jesus.

Biggest influence in your life? God and Max! The odds were against us meeting, but God wanted us together! Max was born at Warner Robbins Air Force Base in Georgia and I was born in Beaumont, TX. When I was two-years-old my family moved to Port Arthur, TX. Max’s family moved there when he was in the third grade. We met in high school. But, even that was unlikely since I was in the 10th grade and he was in the 11th. We were normally in different parts of the big high school, Thomas Jefferson. So, we never saw each other.

However, because Max had an art class, we passed in the hallway one time each day. That is when we spotted each other. Max stared and grinned at me, but he was too

shy to meet me. However, I caught his eye! Finally, tired of waiting on him, when school pictures arrived, I stopped Max in the hall and asked for his picture. I gave him mine. That broke the ice.

I was 16-years-old and Max was 17 at the time. That is how our love story began. I was the bold one, which is funny because I am naturally shy. Max was the shy one! As everyone knows, Max is the bold one who likes to take charge! We were married next to a lake in the east Texas Piney Woods on August 16, 1975, and went to Colorado backpacking and bowhunting for our three week Honeymoon. I truly believe this was God’s plan for our lives. We have been side by side on this crazy adventure with God ever since!

Lowest time in your life? It has to be when we tried to put the Cross up in Kerrville. Little did we know that so many people would object. We got flooded with mail filled with obnoxious, terrible comments from people who did not want the Cross to go up. They would put things in the newspaper that were not true about us. One person wrote in to the paper saying that the Cross would make Kerrville “appear” like a Christian community but it would ruin the skyline. It’s funny now. It was awful then.

Where was God during this low point? That time in our life was one of the lowest points, for sure, but those people who opposed us did not realize that God was on our side! He wanted the Cross to go up on the hilltop and if God is for us, who can stand against us! God was present and God is faithful!

What do you want people to know about Jesus? Trust God. Talk to Jesus about everything. Ask God questions. He wants to talk with you, and He will talk to you in the way you can hear him or that you can see him. He is very personal and loves to do things for you! Do NOT be afraid! Be strong and willing to help others who are in need of a miracle. Everybody has a need. So be ready to pray for them AND pray that those you speak to will be ready to hear you. Be bold. Don’t give up. Trust God.

How did you find the Garden?

In a garden, as in life among human personalities, we are often drawn to the highly visible and flamboyant, like the purple Mystic Spires behind “*The Divine Servant*” sculpture. But in His usual Kingdom way, God employs many to make a few more visible.

Santolina is a quiet but foundational evergreen at the terraced entrance to The Coming King Garden. Ten months of the year, our dark green Santolina mounds gently over the stones, providing a dark green backdrop to its colorful neighbors. It is hardy, loves full sun, tolerates cold, is deer resistant and thrives in several types of soil. May and early June, however, Santolina blooms delightful balls of yellow. Even dedicated gardeners are sometimes surprised by the sudden burst of spring color.

Santolina varieties may also be found with silver-gray or nearly chartreuse foliage. If you try it as a border, groundcover, or visual backdrop for other plants, remember that it does not tolerate over-watering. God loves the quietly supportive members of his creation, as well as the ones drawing the most attention.

TOUR GUIDE/CHAPLAIN Commissionings

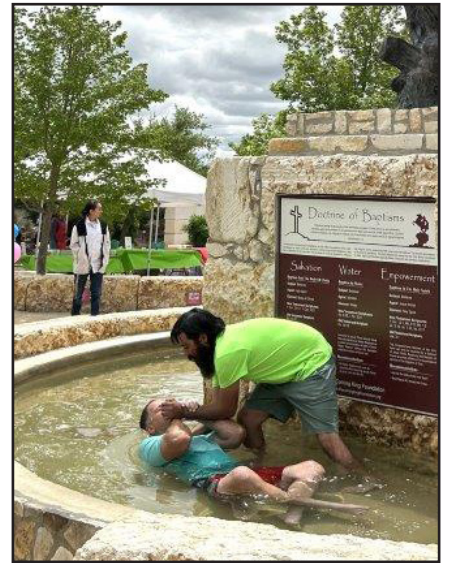

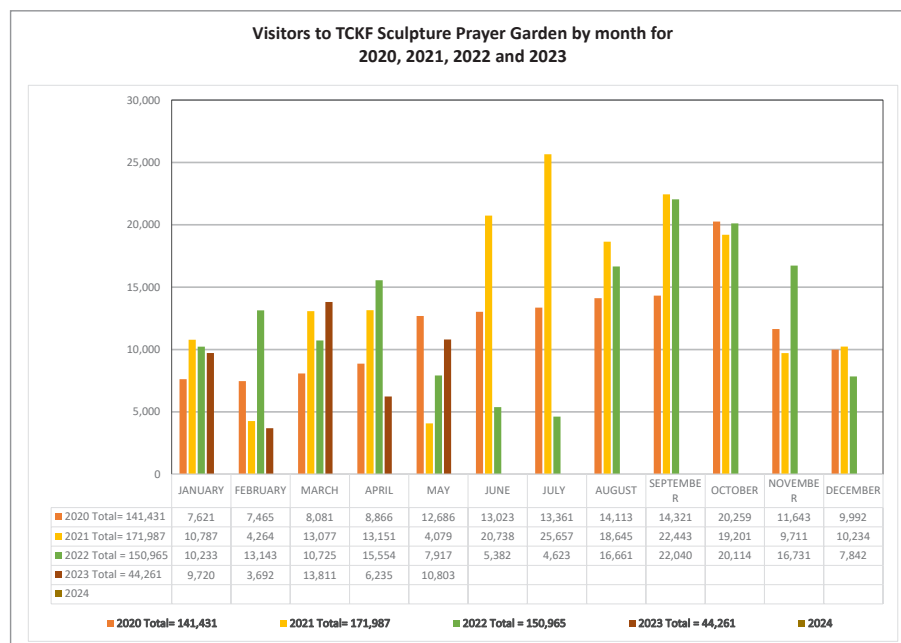

sun, so all light will be blocked out. Kerrville will have 4 minutes and 25 seconds of total darkness, the longest duration time on the planet!

Scientists say that Kerrville is the only city in the direct "centerline" of both eclipses! As a result, NASA has selected our hometown to LIVE stream video

from here which will be seen across the world. The City of Kerrville is now preparing for a giant influx of "eclipse tourists." Predictions are that the crowds could exceed 150,000 visitors to our Hill Country town of approximately 24,000 residents!

A solar eclipse occurs when the moon, the sun and the earth are in perfect alignment. Scientists claim this particular solar phenomenon is a once in a lifetime experience and is the grandest of all astronomical events of this century. The last time a Total Eclipse was seen in Texas was over a hundred years ago. The next solar eclipse won't happen again in the USA until 2045. On average, a Total Eclipse will be seen from one location every 375 years.

The secular world believes these two intersecting eclipses are a nice astronomical coincidence. As believers, we know that God does nothing by accident and that He communicates to the entire world using celestial signs, according to the Bible. Many Christians believe the eclipses are a warning sign from God to America. As we all know, our country is in a terrible place right now. We have rejected the God of the Bible and are now "reaping the whirlwind" (Hosea 8:7). I believe the LORD is telling the world that hope can only be found in the cross of Jesus Christ (John 3:16).

Annually, this Garden has well over a hundred thousand visitors come to the free, non-denominational, spiritual art park to experience the power and presence of the LORD. Documented supernatural miracles have included fulfilled prophecies, signs, wonders, healings and deliverances, angelic sightings and the visible Shekinah Glory of God. In addition, to our knowledge, at least 50 suicides have been canceled on the hill. Thousands of salvations and baptisms have occurred at the 24.5-acre tranquil sculpture garden. In these last days, God is doing something very special on this holy hill in Kerrville, Texas!

This is why God has "marked" Kerrville, Texas with two rare, intersecting eclipses. What can be found at this spot that is nowhere else on earth?

1. This is the only place on the planet where the massive, 77'7" open cross sculpture called *"The Empty Cross"*™ exists. This hollow, red-brown (blood colored) Cor-ten Steel sculpture is the most symbolic cross sculpture ever created. It symbolizes the Way, the Door, the Strong Tower, the Mighty Fortress, the Light and the Resurrection.
2. The Coming King Sculpture Prayer Garden is located in Kerrville. This beautiful, non-denominational, Christian art park was built to honor the God of the Bible (Amos 9:11-12).
3. This multimillion-dollar, private, non-profit (501c3) "art museum" garden is free to the public and welcomes all.
4. 365 days a year, from 7 a.m. until midnight, visitors can read 77 key Bible verses inscribed in stone (in three languages).
5. The central garden is shaped like a giant, 300' long cross when viewed from the air. (It is exactly twice the length of the original Tabernacle in the wilderness.)
6. Since 2010, this unique location on earth has been the place where the God of the Bible is honored and worshipped every day by believers from around the world, as praise music surrounds the cross.
7. The power and peace of God manifests daily at this independent art park which is not owned by any church or ministry. This is a spiritual sculpture garden where non-believers can find the true God without going through organized religion.
8. This prototype, "Covenant Certified" Sculpture Prayer Garden, in the heart of the Texas Hill Country, looks like ISRAEL with its vegetation and rolling, limestone covered hills. Plus, by the sovereignty of God, this "Tabernacle Garden" is located at the same latitude as ISRAEL, halfway between the Pacific and Atlantic Oceans on IH-10.
9. The majestic (larger-than-life), *"Lion of Judah"*™ bronze sculpture stands atop a massive, limestone, Ten Commandments monument, on an outcropping overlooking Kerrville and the trans-continental highway. (The #1 lion statue was donated to ISRAEL by Christians and installed in Jerusalem in 2020.)
10. This garden is a "type" of last days Tabernacle (Isaiah 2: 2-3) where thousands of pilgrims are finding Yeshua the Messiah, the Savior, the LORD Jesus Christ. TCKF believes the coming glory will usher thousands of souls into the Kingdom of God because He has chosen to put His heavenly "crosshairs" over His cross in Kerrville.

Dear friends of Jesus, TCKF is now preparing for a great, "last days" harvest of souls at God's garden, in our community, across America and online.
