The Kingdom Advances!

Thousands of people from around the world claim the presence and power of Almighty God is manifesting on a 1,930' mountain in the Texas Hill Country. Spiritual transformations, miracles, signs and wonders are happening daily at The Coming King Sculpture Prayer Garden in Kerrville, TX. The free, 24.5 acre park is located at the same latitude as Israel, approximately halfway between the Atlantic and Pacific Oceans on IH-10. Thousands of lives are being changed by God on this holy hill, 365 days a year!

People are coming to the non-denominational garden for many reasons. Some are coming to see 2.3 million dollars' worth of donated Christian art. Others are coming to see beautiful landscaping and scenic views.

However, the main draw is the manifest presence of God. The unfinished spiritual park is being built on faith in God, without debt by thousands of Christians, from all denominations. The Body of Christ has unified around the 77' Resurrection cross. This is the "GARDEN REVIVAL"!



On June 6, 2016, newly elected Kerrville Mayor, Bonnie White, visited Kerrville's top tourist attraction and prayed for it's success.



Hundreds of thousands of people have visited The Coming King Sculpture Prayer Garden since it was opened to the public in 2010. Thousands claim to have experienced the power and presence of God, many for the first time.



People are now flying in from other states and countries to see Kerrville's Sculpture Prayer Garden. On July 29, 2016, Dwight Johnson and Ted Beckett flew from Colorado just to visit the Texas spiritual art garden.

TOURISM

The Coming King Sculpture Prayer Garden is the top year-round tourist attraction in Kerrville, and is considered by many to be a national landmark. This claim is based on visitor attendance from around the world, and national and international publicity in all media. The garden has been featured in hundreds newspapers across the USA, thanks to numerous Associated Press articles. Magazines, websites, social media, radio and the TV affiliates of ABC, NBC, CBS, FOX and Time Warner have all done news stories on the garden. The Christian TV networks have also repeatedly covered the garden. CBN's "700 Club" aired a story on March 21, 2016, which was viewed by millions around the world.

In 2015, an estimated 94,593 people visited the spiritual art park. TCKF hopes to exceed 100,000 visitors in 2016. Numbers are tabulated by a Vehicle Counter, and a People Counter, which was donated by Sensource. They provide digital counters to the US Border Patrol, the US Park Service and major museums.

Tourists are driving and flying in from all 50 states and from around the world. As of this date, visitors from 58 countries have been documented. The largest attendance for a single day was an estimated 1,500 visitors, which occurred at the garden Dedication on September 13, 2015. Currently, the average attendance is 372 visitors a day, with the peak periods on the weekends. The free spiritual park is open from 7 AM to midnight.

Guests spend many hours at the meditation garden. The average visit is between one to two hours. The longest documented stay by an out-of-state visitor is 42 consecutive days. Some local people come to the garden almost every day, while many out-of-town guests have returned more than 20 times. Some fans bring bus and van loads of people to the garden, from across Texas and the USA. Large tour groups are now common. Several families have reported moving to Kerrville because the cross is on the hill! Three couples found their mates at the garden!

The Kerrville garden Tabernacle is affecting people like no other tourist attraction anywhere. Thousands of unsolicited good comments have poured in. Currently, a 154 page document of good comments is posted on the TCKF website. Unlike commercial theme parks, the special effects occurring at this tourist attraction are real!

TOUR GUIDE CHAPLAINS

Hundreds of Christians have volunteered at the garden. Currently, 35 Tour Guide Chaplains from many denominations serve at the garden. Easily spotted by their red Servant's Aprons, these trained volunteers greet, answer questions, give tours and pray upon request. "CROSSMOBILE"

In January of 2016, a unique little vehicle started traveling the roads of the Texas Hill Country, sharing the Good News of Jesus Christ. Used primarily to distribute brochures to local businesses, the eye-catching "Crossmobile" can't be missed!



In July, 92 year old Tour Guide Chaplain, Col. Bill Lewis brought his family to the garden to be blessed. Tourists have come from all 50 states and 58 documented countries.



On August 1, 2016 six more Tour Guide Chaplains were certified by Jeff Anderson (center) the "TCKF Fire Marshall" of the 35 volunteer TCKF Tour Guide Chaplains.



"LIVING WATER BAPTISMAL FOUNTAIN"

On May 28, 2016, the "Living Water Baptismal Fountain" at the garden started to operate. Within hours, the first Water Baptism occurred! Now, people can be Water Baptized at the garden, after they have prayed to receive Jesus Christ as LORD and Savior. The Baptismal provides a written explanation of the three types of Christian Baptisms (Hebrews 6:1-2). This information is posted on a large plaque above the water, on the back of "The Coming King" sculpture base. There is much confusion about Christian Baptisms. This plaque, written by Robby Carpenter, DDS and evangelist, Max Greiner, Jr., provides a clear, Biblical explanation, which can also be found on the TCKF website.

The "Living Water Baptismal Fountain" began operation on May 28, 2016. Water Baptisms began the same day. "The Coming King" bronze sculpture was donated by the Greiners and two anonymous donors from Houston.

The beautiful new fountain, with its 7' x 7' waterfall exists because God moved on the hearts of numerous generous Christians. First, Dean and Stella Tinnin, owners of Tinnin Water Well Drilling, donated the expensive deep well. Then, Bobby and Virginia Cason, owners of Mid-Tex Pump Co., donated the pumps and storage tank required to bring the water to the fountain and landscaping.

The new pump house/control room was donated by Jenschke Construction, Terry and Linda Forse, and Johnny and Judy Sharp. The electrical work was donated by Guadalupe Electric, owned by Johnny Flowers. Finally, the new water system would not have been possible without Joe Ed Jenschke, owner of Jenschke Construction. He donated the expensive trenches that were cut into solid limestone, on top of the mountain, for the water and electric lines.

Thanks to these generous followers of Jesus Christ, visitors can now enjoy the sight and sound of the "Living Water Baptismal Fountain"!

LANDSCAPING

The garden now has many beautiful trees and plants, thanks to the new water system and donations of supporters. Several professional landscaping companies have donated their services, plants, trees and flowers for the glory of God. Robert Underwood, owner of AAA Landscape, and Billy Long, owner of Gardens At The Ridge, each donated their services. Paul Newsome, owner of Newsome Sprinklers, donated an electronic irrigation system for the top of the mountain.

Love Creek Orchards, owned by Bryan and Stacie Hutzler, donated 42 large Maple trees, which line the 300' cross-shaped garden, like columns in a cathedral. These beautiful trees have been named the "Found Maples" so tourists looking for the famous "Lost Maples State Park" will now come to Jesus at the Kerrville cross! Other mature hardwood trees were donated by Sam and JoAnn Watson, owners of Watson Tree Farm. Rick Martin, owner of Martin Landscape, also donated his work to help build the "Prayer Path" and install the custom engraved concrete Pavers, at the bottom of the garden. Tom Wren, owner of Rockscapes donated the red rocks that fill the cross planters in the 300' cross-shaped garden.

Many volunteers maintain the landscaping. They are led by expert gardener and TCKF Trustee, Kathy Lyles, who does an amazing job.

NEW PLAQUE MONUMENTS

Visitors can now see many new plaques around the garden which explain spiritual truths, the locations of garden miracles and the scriptural basis of the artwork which was donated by Max and Sherry Greiner, Monte and Beverly Paddleford, and David and Michelle Broussard. The "Ten Commandments", the "Lord's Prayer" and the "Father's Blessing" limestone monuments are displayed near "The Empty Cross".

For many people, the scriptures displayed in the garden are the first Bible verses they have ever read. Remarkably, many visitors actually read every plaque and Scripture Tile in the garden! As a result, their lives are never the same, and the Kingdom of God advances!



Construction at the garden continues as donations are received. The original, 300' cross-shaped garden was completed and celebrated with a Dedication service on September 13, 2015, Rosh Hashanah.



On July 22, 2016, a meeting was held by volunteers to discuss landscaping at the 24.5 acre garden. Kathy Lyles (center in blue) heads the TCKF Landscape Committee. Six professional landscape companies are donating their services.



Throughout the 24.5 acre garden, numerous plaques share scriptural truths and significant miracles that have happend.

MINISTRY

One of the remarkable things about The Coming King Sculpture Prayer Garden in Kerrville, TX is that thousands of people are literally experiencing the power, presence, and peace of God for the first time in their lives. And, it is happening outside the walls of the organized church. It is happening in a garden. This is the "GARDEN REVIVAL!"

Thousands of tourists are learning about the one true God, not from preachers, priests, evangelists, books, websites, crusades, TV or radio shows, but from the Holy Spirit Himself, using the holy scripture, and Christ-honoring monumental sculptures, in a non-confrontational garden setting. God is using the eye to draw the spirit of man to Himself. This is an "out of the box" method of evangelism. This is "EYE-GATE EVANGELISM!"

There are 77 specially selected Bible verses in multiple languages, which present the full Gospel of Jesus Christ, from the Old and New Testaments to visitors; many of whom have never read the Bible. The 16" Scripture Tiles quietly present God's Word, in a 300' long cross-shaped garden, to tourists in a literal "Path To Salvation". Once inside the 7' wide center of the 77' open cross, pilgrims can read four large Prayer Plaques. These plaques explain Christian Salvation, Empowerment, Baptism, Healing and Miracles. There is no condemnation or judgement in the center of the cross, only mercy, grace and love!

The curious are being drawn off the highway by the Holy Spirit and transformed, to their surprise. People are being Saved, Empowered, Water Baptized and healed physically and emotionally, at the foot of "The Empty Cross".

Unlike typical churches, the Holy Spirit uses the non-denominational art park 365 days a year. People can also connect with God Himself, without going through another person. Visitors are finding God, in His free, outdoor garden Tabernacle, without having go through organized religion. God's garden is open every day to all people, from 7:00 AM until midnight. This is the "GARDEN REVIVAL!"



395 people arrived at the 2016 "Son Rise Easter Servie" in the dark and rain. However, the rain stopped and a beautiful sunrise burst forth. People were Saved, Baptized, healed and sprinkled in the Shekinah Glory dust on the holy mountain.



On the Saturday prior to Easter, Christians from many denominations came together to worship Jesus Christ, at the foot of "The Empty Cross". Bands, choirs and pastors led the people in worship during the "Resurrection Celebration".


EASTER 2016

During Easter 2016, Jesus Christ was magnified on His mountain by worshippers from many denominations. Over the four days surrounding the Christian holiday, 3,252 people from 27 states and four countries converged on Kerrville, TX to celebrate the Resurrection of Jesus Christ!

On Saturday, TCKF held a free "Resurrection Celebration" LIVE concert, from 11:00 AM until 6:00 PM, featuring six Christian bands, choirs and worship teams, from many churches across the region. Unity in the Body of Christ was evident when music groups, pastors and evangelists from different Christian denominations came together to lift up Jesus Christ, in word and song.

On Easter Sunday morning, 395 pilgrims braved the rain and darkness to attend the two hour "Son Rise Service." It included LIVE worship by Louada Raschke's "A Cross Generation Band", testimony by Max Greiner, Jr., and the Word was preached Jimmy Sportsman, Pastor of Kerrville Church of Christ. As a result, souls were Saved, people were filled with the Holy Spirit and several guests were supernaturally healed by God, after prayer. Signs and wonders of the Shekinah Glory dust (Isa 60:1) and the Angel Orbs (Ezk 1:15) also manifested that day.

Over a hundred volunteers made the two day celebration possible, thanks to the coordination efforts of Jeff Anderson, of ServKerrville, and TCKF Trustee, Louada Raschke. Lives were changed forever at the 2016 TCKF Easter events. This is the "GARDEN REVIVAL!"

TCKF RADIO SHOW

Saturday, September 3, 2016 marks the 87th weekly broadcast of "The Cross At Kerrville" radio program. The 30 minute show honors the Holy Spirit and His work at the Sculpture Prayer Garden in Kerrville, TX. Unlike other Christian radio programs, this show is about a place, not preaching or teaching. It features testimony, the amazing personal stories of people who have been touched powerfully by the Holy Spirit at God's art garden. The Bible says that "by the word of their testimony, they defeated the works of Satan" (Rev 12:11).

The radio program idea came from professional Radio Producer, Roy Holley. For years, Roy tried to convince Max Greiner that he should do a weekly radio program about The Coming King Sculpture Prayer Garden. Finally, in November of 2014, Roy told Max that a time slot on Saturday morning had opened up on KSLR, the largest Christian station in San Antonio. Max agreed to pray with Sherry about the opportunity and began discussions with KSLR. However, Max was hesitant because he did not want to be distracted from his main mission for God, which was to build the Sculpture Prayer Garden in Kerrville.

To Max's amazement, on December 4, 2014, God confirmed His will for the Greiners when they drove two hours to hear Dr. Mahesh Chavda preach in Austin, TX at Cathedral of Praise Church. Years before, on December 9, 2001, Dr. Chavda publically prophesied to the Greiners, who were strangers at the time, "You will be involved in the restoration of the Tabernacle of David." (Isa 2:2, Amos 9:11).

Now, 13 years later, Dr. Chavda again publically prophesied over the Greiners at the service saying that God was about to do a "new thing" through them, "on the side" and that it was "alright to do." Chavda did not know the Greiners were prayerfully considering the radio show idea, which could reach thousands of people.

The second confirmation came after the service, when old friend, Gene Bender, walked up to Max and said he just bought an Austin Christian radio station and was looking for a radio program about the Holy Spirit! Max and Sherry told Gene and his wife, Gayle, that they were considering hosting a show on the Holy Spirit's activities at the Kerrville garden. The four prayed for God's will, confirmations and provision, if they were to do a radio program on KTXW 1120 in Austin, and KSLR 630 in San Antonio. Max was uncertain, and needed another confirmation.

So, Max put out a spiritual "fleece" and asked God to raise up Sponsors to cover the cost of this new TCKF evangelistic outreach, if this was His will. Max did not want to use any of the funds that were donated specifically to build the garden.

Within a few days, to Max's amazement, a couple from Impact Christian Fellowship in Kerrville, Gwen and Larry Burnes, said they believed that God wanted them to support the garden on a monthly basis, and also support a radio ministry! "The Cross At Kerrville" radio show answered both desires!

Max's "fleece" was to simply cover the cost of producing the radio show, without taking any funds away from the TCKF building fund. By the grace of God, Sponsors for the weekly radio program suddenly appeared! When God gives a vision, He also gives provision!

Sponsors of the TCKF radio program have included Larry and Gwen Burns, Mamacita's restaurants, the YO Ranch Hotel, Mark and Karen Greiner, the Storehouse Food Pantry in Austin, John and Brenda Miller, owners of National Car Sales in Kerrville, and Cathedral Of Praise Church in Austin, TX, pastored by Sue and Bill Hart. Day and night, the Gospel of Jesus Christ is presented to thousands of people, using 16" ceramic Scripture Tiles, in a "Path to Heaven." Many people are reading the Word of God for the very first time.
