Hill Country Get Ready!

Citizens of earth! The King of kings is about to bless the Texas Hill Country in ways you can't imagine! God has chosen a 1,930' mountain in Kerrville, located at the same latitude as Israel, where Jesus Christ will be honored forever! **The Coming King Sculpture Prayer Garden** being built now is a "type" of last days Tabernacle (Isa 2:3 & Amos 9:11).

Thousands will come to this holy mountain from around the nation and the world. Pilgrims will be drawn by God and the sight of *"The Empty Cross"*_{TM}, a giant, 77'7', \$2,000,000 contemporary sculpture. Visitors will come to experience the presence of God and supernatural miracles happening at the 23 acre spiritual garden. President of the New York Theological Seminary, Henry Kang said: *"The Jewel of Texas is in Kerrville because of the cross!"* The Cor-tin steel cross is destined to become an internationally recognized landmark.

The Coming King Foundation, a non-profit 501c3 arts organization, is building the \$5,000,000 non-denominational garden on IH-10. The free spiritual park is located at the main entrance of Kerrville, TX. Construction resumed after a three year delay due to opposition of atheists and others opposed to the symbolic "Resurrection" cross. Edmund Jenschke, Inc. is building the front entrance of the garden, which should be opened to the public before summer.

This current phase of the construction was made possible by the **Hal & Charlie Peterson Foundation**, and major gifts from John and Barbara Sullivan, Lyle and Patsy Jordan, Trish Wyatt and my family. Since the beginning in 2005, the park has been built on faith in God, without debt, public tax money or professional fundraisers. Over \$2,000,000 has been donated to the non-profit project by Christians across America.


More than a dozen monumental sculptures, worth \$3,000,000, have been donated by three different internationally collected Christian sculptors, Beverly Paddleford of Lander, WY, David Broussard of Dallas, TX and me. This spiritually symbolic cross was donated by Monte and Beverly Paddleford, owners of **Eagle Bronze**, one the largest art foundries in the world, and by my family. However, hundreds of other Christians, ministries, companies and foundations across the USA have donated their resources and services to build this project to honor Jesus Christ.

Community leaders support the project. Stacie Keeble, Kerrville City Council member said: "I love seeing the cross! I just love it!" Sudie Burditt, Director of the Convention & Visitors Bureau exclaimed, "The cross really does take your breath away! It's dignified and awe-inspiring. Visitors for generations will come, eat, sleep and shop in Kerrville, making a positive growth impact on our hospitality industry."

Ray Watson, Executive Director, Kerrville Economic Development Corporation wrote: "What a great project! I look forward to this (Kerrville garden) being the jewel of this area." Todd Parton, Kerrville City Manager commented: "This is a neat project. It is unique, there is nothing like it." Mindy Wendele, Director of Business & Public Affairs said: "It (the garden) is really going to be tremendous."

Local clergy support the garden too. Pastor of Friendship Bible Church, Mark Rylander proclaimed: "What starts on this hill top will flow down to Kerrville, the Hill Country, Texas, this country and the world!" Pastor David Danielson of Impact Christian Fellowship wrote: "The Coming King Sculpture Prayer Garden is already a tremendous blessing to Kerrville in so many ways. I believe it is just a matter of time before it becomes a resource that creates significant revenue for local businesses."
