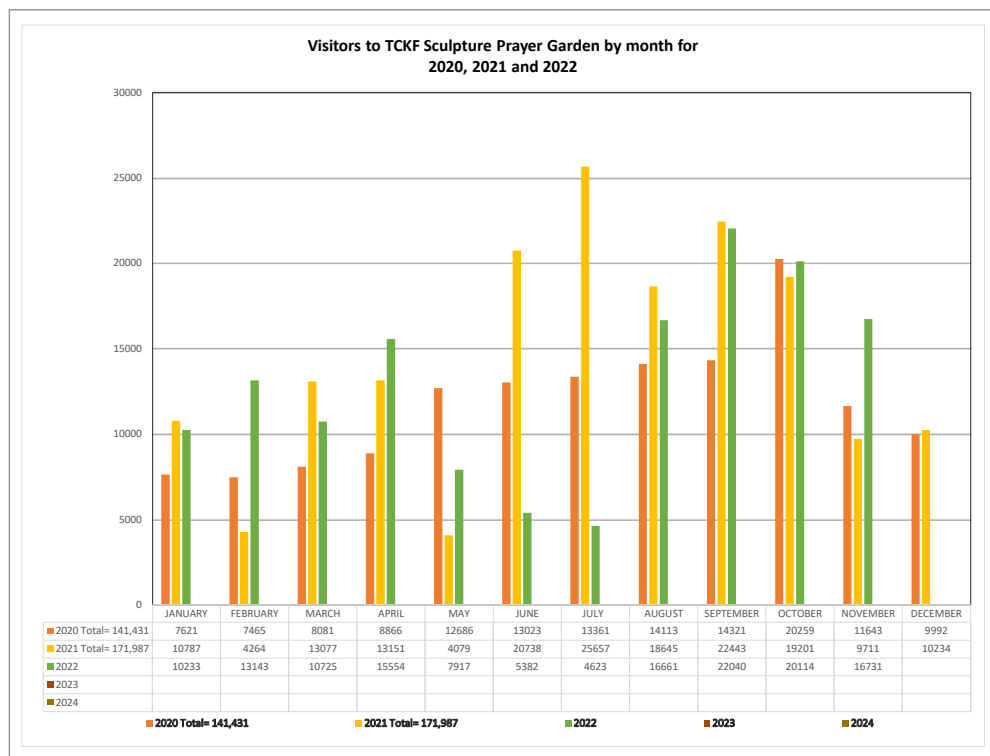

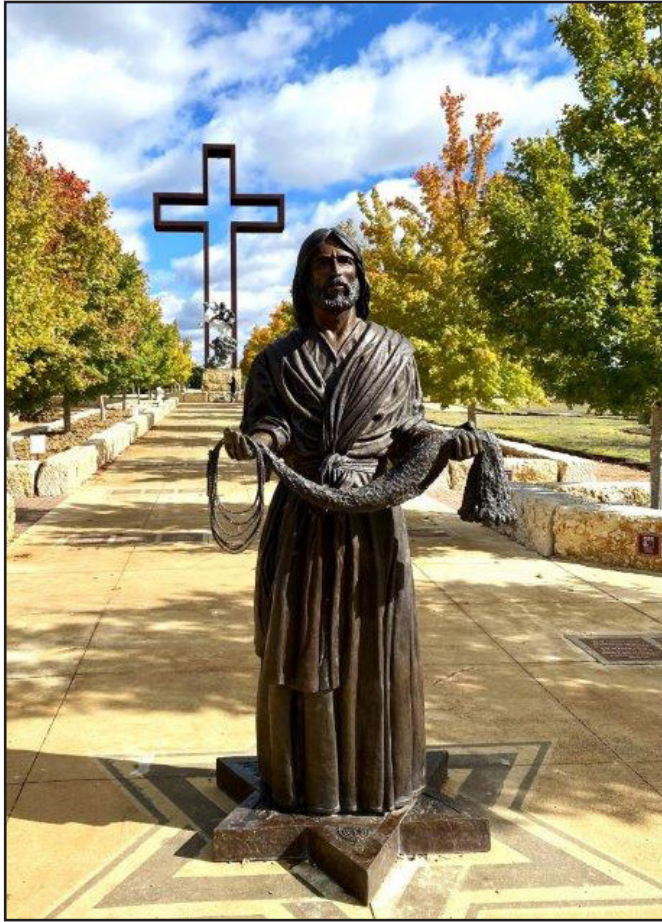

Priority 1 – Immediate need

PREPARED IN THE SHIPYARDS

Where are you from? New Orleans, LA

How did you meet Jesus? I met a young man in welding school. He was a rough guy whose street name was "Killer" Foster. Two years later, I see this guy again in the shipyard where we both worked. He started talking to me on the job about God. He told me how he had been on his death bed and even the doctors didn't think he'd make it to the next morning, but his parents stayed up all night praying. While they prayed, they both felt something pass by them and go to the bed where "Killer" laid. The next morning, he was alive. The only answer was "BUT GOD!" "Killer" couldn't read, but after he got saved, God gave him the ability to read the Bible and learn Scripture. He kept telling me about Jesus. I was raised in Catholicism so I didn't understand much about the Bible, so it challenged me because I'd grown up hearing mostly about Mary. "Killer" wouldn't stop talking to me about Jesus. One night I said, "You get one more shot, then I don't want to hear another word about Jesus." We sat on the levy all night and he witnessed to me about Jesus. Something hit me when I realized at any time I could have died in the rough area where I lived. It shook me when "Killer" said, "How many Catholics could go to hell because they don't know Jesus?" Everything changed for me that night. A force hit my life and I became so hungry to know more about the Lord. My life changed. My music changed. My clothes changed. My understanding about God changed. I threw out all my alcohol and cigarettes. My cussing and even my temper was gone. Everything changed because "Killer" fell in love with Jesus and had to tell someone about it....me.

How did you find the Garden? I was at an old fashion tent revival in New Orleans where a man prophesied about the wickedness coming to New Orleans. This was years ago, and I had just bought a house in New Orleans.

God put it on my heart to get out of New Orleans and head to Texas. I didn't know anyone there, but I knew I had to go. My wife and I, along with our kids, and several other family members, even some of our friends moved with us to Texas. We came in through San Antonio, then to Seguin, and in time we found Kerrville. I fell in love with Kerrville and the Hill Country. I was a welder and by God's favor, I opened my own welding shop. Some years after, I'd heard that the Prayer Garden needed help. They needed welders to weld the Cross. I went to their meeting and said, "I have to be a part of this!" I literally saw the Cross get welded from the ground up. Daniel Wolfe and I were the two welders who finished welding the Cross at the top. That was how I found the Garden; God wanted a welder from New Orleans.

Biggest influence in your life? I love God! I gotta have Him! When I discovered obedience through love, it changed everything. I can't imagine living without God or living any other way! He has been so good to me in ways I can't even explain and in ways that are better than anything I can have without Him. I have lived in His favor and blessing because I learned to obey His voice.

Lowest time in your life? When I was newly saved, I started witnessing to my family, telling them "I got saved!" My family wanted nothing to do with it, especially my mom. At one point, my mom said, "If you change your religion, you are no longer my son." That was tough.

Where was God during this low point? During this same time, a tent revival came to town, and I heard about receiving the Holy Spirit. I wanted it. I wanted to speak in tongues like the Bible talks about. That night, as we were praising, the Holy Spirit came down and I felt electricity all through my body and I began speaking in tongues. I felt alive and free, like never before. God started bringing people into my life to show me and teach me more about Him. In time, most of my family received Jesus, too - even my mom. She grew to love Jesus with a passion! God never leaves you.

How do you serve in the Garden? My first love is to be in the Garden worshipping and praising God. I began serving as a volunteer welder, first welding the Cross, then later making the 7 donation boxes in the Garden along with modifying the "Lion of Judah" trailer. Currently, I volunteer on the Board of Trustees and serve as interim Treasurer.

What do you want people to know about Jesus? You don't go by what you see or hear. Never believe the negative or anything that is against believing God! My God is able to do all things, and all things are possible with Him. Trust God with everything. Believe Him no matter what you're seeing. I believe God honors those who trust in Him. Don't complain. I never complain. I believe what the Bible says, **"Trust in the Lord!"**

MY HELP COMES FROM THE LORD

How do you serve in the Garden? I am the Administrative Assistant in the TCKF office and have been a Tour Guide/Chaplain for the last 5 ½ years. I get paid to serve in the office, but the best part of my job is when someone walks through the door. I know that God brought them in, and He is orchestrating something specifically for them. I also read and pray over the Comment Cards and send each person a personal letter. Sometimes people call the office and they are suicidal, desperate, or weeping, and my heart just goes out to them. I say, “Lord, thank you for what you’re about to do for this person.” The moment I start speaking, it’s not my words, but God’s words coming out of my mouth, saying what Holy Spirit wants said to them. God gave me a compassionate heart. I know God gives me the words for each person. It is such a blessing to be able to give them comfort. God is our source. Being an Administrative Assistant is my ministry.

Where are you from? LaGrange, TX.

How did you meet Jesus? My parents. My family. We were like the Waltons. I grew up on a ranch with my parents and brother and on Sundays we were in church. In Jr. High I was very active in Sunday school and youth retreats. Those were my most meaningful times, and where I had several “mountain top” experiences with God. These youth retreats are where I learned what it meant to be a Christian, not just what it meant to be in church.

How did you find the Garden? I wasn’t looking for the Garden. I was living in a small town and in a short period of one year, I suffered a number of deaths in my family and then a severe car accident. One day I told my husband Buddy, “I’ve got to get out of this town. It’s too painful.” So,

we came looking to buy land and a place to live. I knew no one in Kerrville, but we saw that Cross, and we knew we wanted to live here. We started visiting the Cross each time we came to find our next home.

Biggest influence in your life? My parents. They were deeply rooted Christians.

Lowest time in your life? It began in September 2006, when my father passed away and then three months later, in January 2007, my mother unexpectedly passed away. Then, in March of 2007, my only brother suddenly died and in June 2007, my first husband died of colon cancer. We weren’t married at the time, but nonetheless, he died, too. Then in November 2007, my daughter and I were in a devastating car accident where I had to be cut out of the car. I prayed, “Lord, please get my daughter out of the car. I’m ready to go but save her.” I felt an amazing peace and felt God calling me home. But then God saved both of us. From 2007-2012, I went thru 10 major surgeries: 2 for my neck and 8 for my back. Those were the hardest years of my life and I’d ask God, “Why did you keep me here?”

Where was God during this low point? God was right in my face. It would have been so much easier to go (to heaven), but my belief and my faith in God were the only things that brought me through. He’s been my rock and the center of my life, through good times and bad times, at all times, I choose to praise and worship the Lord. He brought me through and brought me here, to the Garden, to be an encourager and speak words of comfort for others who are hurting and need to find Him, too.

What do you want people to know about Jesus? – Jesus Christ is our Lord and our Savior. He will never leave your side. We are His children. We can never push Him away. Choose to praise and worship Him... at all times.

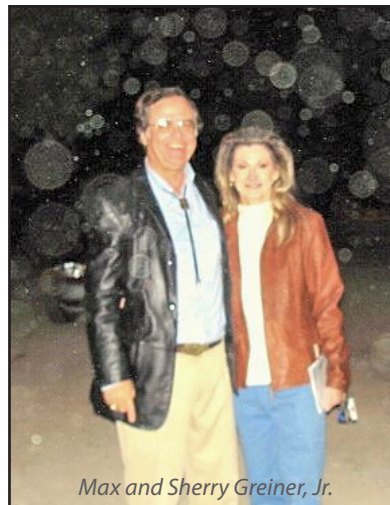

FUN GOD STUFF...Angel Orbs By Max Greiner, Jr., TCKF Chairman

I am a guy who long ago asked God not to do anything fun without me! What I am about to share is the “fun stuff” that regularly happens at The Coming King Sculpture Prayer Garden, which has become famous for its miracles, signs and wonders. We have hundreds of thousands of “pilgrims” who travel to this free spiritual art park from every state and from approximately one hundred countries drawn by the power and presence of God. This Garden is a “type” of last days Tabernacle (*Isaiah 2:2, Amos 9:11 & Micah 4:1*). Genuine supernatural miracles occur daily as thousands of people seek the God of the Bible. The Coming King, Jesus Christ, also known as Yeshua, the Messiah of the Jews and The Lion of Judah, is on the 1,930’ mountain 365 days a year! Last month (November 2022) an estimated 16,731 people climbed the “Holy Hill” in search of God (*Psalms 121:1*).

Literally thousands of people have been born-again at the foot of “The Empty Cross.” Thousands more have been water baptized in the “Living Water Fountain” and baptized in the Holy Spirit inside the cross. By the love of God, many souls have been delivered from abuse, shame, guilt, pain, homosexuality, and demonization. Physical and emotional healings occur frequently when people pray the four prayers posted inside the 77’7” Cor-ten steel open cross. To my knowledge, at least 50 people have canceled their plans for suicide while on the Garden property. Doctors and counselors frequently direct their patients to the non-denominational, Christian healing garden.

In addition to these “first-order” miracles, other signs and wonders occur continuously on the anointed property. Thousands of people from all backgrounds and faiths have witnessed signs and wonders which testify to the God of the Bible. Hundreds of these miracles are documented in my book, “The Garden – Art Of Faith” (www.thegardenbook.net). The large, 490-page illustrated tome is available in print and as a digital book.

A “common” miracle experienced by many people is the sudden appearance of the Shekinah Glory Dust (*Ex 34:29, Isa 60:1 & Acts 7:55*). This sparkling substance looks like fine glitter. Since 2005, the “Glory Dust” has formed on the skin, clothes, and Bibles of thousands of Garden visitors. The strange particles have also been witnessed around the cross as a swirling Glory Cloud (*1 Kings 8:10*).

One of the most amazing supernatural miracles that occurs repeatedly in this Garden park is the sudden appearance of Angel Orbs (*Ezekiel 1:15*). Thousands of strange balls of light have appeared in photographs over Believers. Normally, the orbs show up during worship, praise, or prayer. These bubbles of light can be photographed best at night. However, they can also be captured in the daylight if a flash is used. The spheres range from almost transparent to solid, opaque white. Occasionally, they have pale colors. I have even photographed orbs with four rings comprised of dots that look like eyes, just as described by the Old Testament prophet Ezekiel.

I first became aware of the Angel Orbs on September 15, 2005, when Prayer Intercessor, Margie Osborne, sent me photos of Angel Orbs around her father and grandchildren when he received Christ in Colorado. Then in 2006, the pastor of Impact Christian Fellowship in Kerrville, David Danielson, sent me photos of strange balls of light floating around the church sanctuary. The transparent orbs were captured in the pictures taken for the new church website.

The moment Sherry and I looked at the Impact digital photos on my computer screen, the Holy Spirit told us these were the type of angels referred to by Ezekiel. Later, after taking photos of thousands of round balls of light, the Holy Spirit woke me and said to write a rational, well-illustrated essay explaining the phenomenon. He wanted to use it on my art website to bring thousands of people to Jesus. His target was sinners lost in the occult, witchcraft, New Age, and false religions.

Therefore, in 2007 I wrote an evangelistic Angel Orb essay and posted it on my Greiner art website, in the "God Stuff" section. Countless numbers of people have seen my dramatic orb images and read my evangelistic essay. I still may have the best photographs and Biblical explanation of the orb phenomenon on the internet. The Holy Spirit directed people to my essay after orbs started appearing in their own photographs. For years, my essay was at the top of all the internet search engines. I used this rare opportunity to reach the really lost for Christ.

So, what are Angel Orbs exactly? After years of praying, researching, and photographing thousands of these strange balls of light, I believe they are angels, God's angels. Angel Orbs are made of something which reflects light. Apparently, they don't emit their own light. Many times they have appeared at my request, in daylight and dark. The orbs can float motionless in the air or move at a high rate of speed. We have viewed many videos of the orbs moving through space over the years. We posted our own video taken at Impact Christian Fellowship which shows the Angel Orbs flying through the sanctuary. I have also photographed the Angel Orbs hovering over our vehicles, large Christian sculptures, floating over our studio home, and even over Sherry's pet wild animals in the Texas Hill Country.



The phenomenon is real. It is not a digital camera anomaly. Remember, all cameras at times will create light flares due to bright light entering the lens. I have a photo of an Angel Orb hovering over one of my California Prayer Intercessors, Deb Fry, in a family photo from the sixties. Film cameras were the only option back then. So, orbs are not a product of digital cameras. Digital cameras are just better tools to photograph Angel Orbs, just like microscopes and telescopes are better tools to observe things that can't be seen with the naked eye.

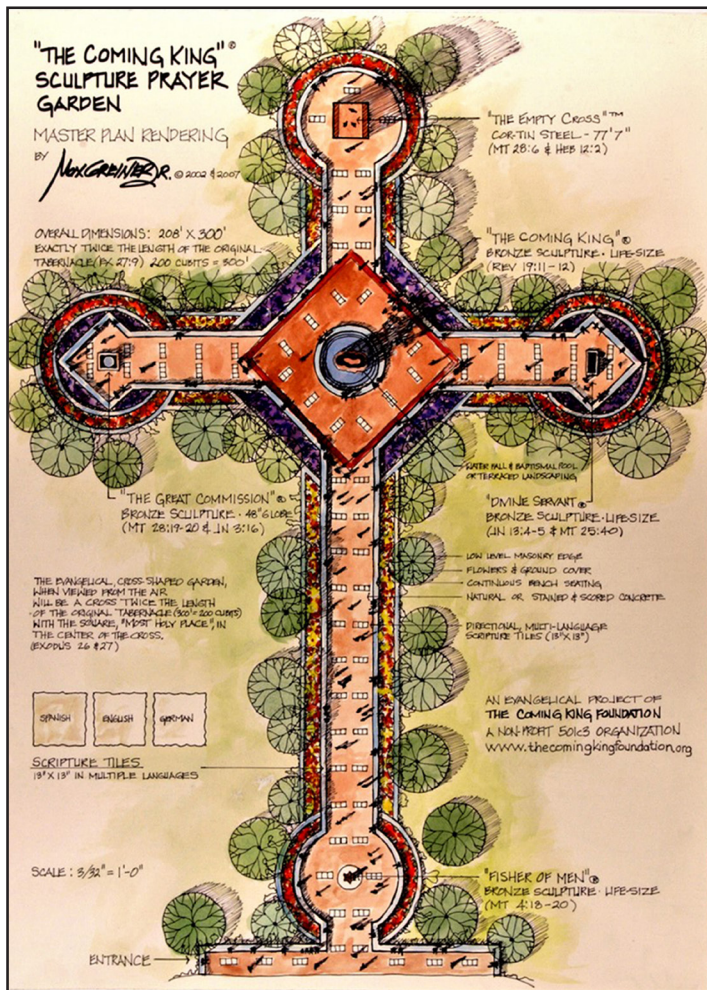
Since the development of smart phones (such as iPhones and Androids) their software now automatically removes orbs and other perceived flaws from images. Only digital cameras without image correction technology can capture orb images. Therefore, I use Canon Digital cameras to take still photographs of Angel Orbs today.

However, smart phones do a great job taking videos of the Angel Orbs flying through the air. Simply pray, turn on the camera flash and take a video. Bobby Dendy, Worship evangelist and Prayer Intercessor, was the first person to inform me that Angel Orbs could be captured on video using smart phones. He was also the first to send me photographs of gigantic Angel Orbs floating over "The Empty Cross" in Kerrville. Orbs usually appear to be the size of golf balls up to beachball-size.

Remember, God has always used miracles, signs and wonders to capture the attention of humans. He never stopped and God's Garden in Kerrville is a wonderful place to photograph Angel Orbs. God's angels are everywhere. They are around you and your family now. Let me remind you, however, only worship God, not angels. As a warning, so you are aware, Satan's fallen angels can be photographed too, in occult situations. They are not demons, which are terrestrial. If you don't know what you've got in your photos, command the Angel Orbs to leave if they don't serve Jesus. They will exit stage right ...or left!
